

FRENCH STREAKIN JESS was the winner of \$20,000 in the Slot Race with Hallie Hanssen...

His name is French Streakin Jess aka Jess. He is 5 years old and a red roan stallion. His sire is A Streak Of Fling and he is out of the mare PC Frenchmans Flirt. PC Frenchmans Flirt is a full sister to Frenchmans Guy. He comes from a great line of horses raised by Tom and Barb Westover. I've ridden quite a few of them--French Streaktovegas, French Streakofbling, French Streakin Izzy, and French Streaking Gem.

I got him for a few months when he was a 3 year old to start on the pattern. He took to it so easy and is a natural barrel horse. I sent him home in October of his 3-year-old year and then got him back in May as a 4 year old. He bred some mares until the end of June and then we exhibitioned him about 7 or 8 times in the fall before the BFA. We started him there and he worked really well for his first event--he just missed making the finals.

In the first go of the Greg Olson I felt like he was having a little trouble with the ground. He really likes to drag his butt and it felt like he was sliding more than usual. In the second go he handled himself better and it all worked out. He tries so hard and is really fast.

This was the first time I have won the slot race at the Greg Olson. In the last few years I have been getting into the slot races more and this one was sure an honor to win. There are always a really tough group of horses in AZ and to come down here the first part of the season and run a 17.1 on a standard feels great.

My goals for the remainder of the season are to consistently place at the major futurities and have happy horses at the end of the year. I really don't run my horses a lot besides at the futurities. I want them to love their job and crave running barrels so I try not to overdo it.

Jess hates to have his legs wrapped. We have tried it all and he will pull them off and make sure you can't use them again. I warm him up in a Loomis Bit and run him in a Dave Elliot Spur Up-13. I use a saddle by Tami Semas with a Classic Equine Zone pad. My leg gear is Iconiclast and bell boots.

For hay and grain I use a good quality alfalfa and Woodys Sales Prep; I also use Omega Fields Horseshine and SureGut supplements. Alternative therapies include Polyglycan shots, Omeperzole, Respond blanket and Flexineb.







Performance Horse Stallions contacted the owners of Jess Being Valiant to ask them a few questions so our viewers can get to know them better ...

4N RANCH BY KASEY ETBAUER...4N is located in the small Oklahoma panhandle town of Goodwell. 4N is an old Nichols family brand belonging to my grandfather Gilbert Nichols. My husband Dan and I operate a small training and breeding program for ourselves, my parents, Howard and Laurie Nichols, as well as Elyse and Tony Cullum and Dallas and Valerie Howell. We also manage a small cattle operation for the Howell's. In 2015 we integrated Jess Being Valiant, a 2010 stallion owned by my parents into our program. We manage the barrel racing & arena business end, while Burns Ranch stands him and handles all breeding and horse racing business.

The ranch is primarily Dan and I (which is why we try to keep it small); we hire a few college kids from OPSU (Oklahoma Panhandle State University) each year to help out with chores and basic upkeep. We have a couple young men that help Dan start the colts. My parents live in AZ, but they are a big part of the program. Modern technology allows my parents to follow along with the training, help with ideas or give advice. They have a lot of experience under their belts!

My parents are also very involved with horse racing and my great grandfather, Abe Nichols owned Clabber, the first AQHA World Champion race horse. Dan grew up in SD in a ranching, rodeo family. He is a 10x NFR qualifier in Saddle Bronc Riding, Reserve PRCA Saddle Bronc Riding Champion, multiple Prairie Circuit champion, Calgary Champion, National Circuit Champion and NFR pick up man.

Our life and program was sidelined for a bit a couple years ago, Dan was airlifted to Amarillo, TX for emergency surgery to remove a blood clot in his small intestine. They removed a foot of his intestine; in horse terms, he had colic surgery! It has been a long journey with a few setbacks, but we're slowly getting back on track. We enjoy messing with the colts and watching them progress; we also love roping. It's something fun we can do together. We're just now finally getting back to all the things we enjoy. I'd love to see Dan finally enter some ropings this year and I hope to have a couple futurity horses for 2017. Now that Dan is able to ride again, we plan to have more horses offered for sale later this year and into next. Breeding season is coming up; we really enjoy this time of year. The babies are so fun. Breeding can bring great joy, great sorrow or great frustration. I've had to learn to accept that it doesn't always go as planned. We tend to ride a lot of mares, so embryo transfers (ET) allow us to continue to compete on them and not wait to get a foal down the road.

We recently retired our top mare, Fashion Star Flit. As she aged, she was having difficulty carrying a foal past 30 days; ET allowed us to have several more babies from her. It has been a big asset for us over the years.

We currently have mares that are running bred, cow bred and barrel racing bred. Jesse has such a great mind and good conformation that we feel he'll cross on just about anything. We have found a lot of success with Firewater Flit, Judge Cash, PC Bronsin, Clydus X (ApHC), Sail On Bunny and Dash Ta Fame. We always bought colts and trained them for ourselves prior to ever breeding a mare. These are the bloodlines that we found success with or had a history of success, so that's what we wanted in our program. We have two mares due to foal this year by Jesse and plan to breed 5 mares this year; that's a good manageable number for us. 2016 is Jesse's first foal crop so we will have offspring for sale in the near future.

JESS BEING VALIANT aka Jesse is owned by my parents, Howard and Laurie Nichols. They bought him as a yearling in the Ruidoso Sale with intentions of running him in CA. His pedigree is nothing short of amazing, but his maternal side is what stood out to them. He has a very strong maternal line. We brought him here for Dan to start before going to the track. He was so easy from the get go and so willing. He won \$191,735 and AQHA Superior Race Horse honors. He retired sound mentally and physically, which speaks volumes in my opinion. Jaime Gomez, his trainer, spoke so highly of Jesse. "He has the best mind, I trained Walk Thru Fire and Corona Cartel, and Jesse has the same mind as them; always acted like geldings. He's a great stallion for 3 good reasons: good conformation, good mind, and he has 3 good mamas on his bottom side; 3 blue hen mamas, that makes a great stallion. He was a runner and he's going to throw runners. I strongly recommend him." My parents enjoy owning racehorses, but have never stood a stallion. It wasn't something they'd considered when they originally purchased Jesse. My mom is not scared to geld one and prefers to. If you ask her she'll tell you she actually forgot he was a stud because he never acted like one! They had several offers to buy Jesse, so towards the end of 2014 they had to make a decision. They felt he offered everything they liked in a stallion: winning record, pedigree, mind, conformation, soundness, good eye, and heart. He's also my mom's favorite color to boot! They decided to take an untraveled road for them and stand him. His first year to stand was 2015 so we're very excited to see his first crop arrive this year.

GOALS: We really want to see Jesse's offspring find success in the arena and on the racetrack. We really feel he's going to be a versatile stallion in that aspect. We plan on training for multiple events along with offering some for sale to the public. My parents are flushing a couple of their good running mares that are still at the track to him. The plan is to run them. We all just love Jesse for so many reasons. He has brought us a lot of joy and we hope others will see in him what we do. It takes time to build a program. It's a long process, but we'll keep learning and promoting Jesse the best we can.

OTHER INTERESTS? Hmmm, we don't have much free time! Dan volunteers every week helping at rough stock practice during the OPSU rodeo year. He loves helping those kids

learn. He also loves football season! I enjoy reading and just a lazy day with friends. If we ever take any kind of vacation it's very short or while we're at an event.

THANK YOU! We're always thankful to the people and horses that have helped us along the way. When Dan and I decided to buy one broodmare and 'see how it goes', we bought a little mare named Fashion Star Flit. We had no idea she'd make such a huge impact on our lives and we are so thankful to Elyse Cullum for selling her to us. I also want to thank Shelly Martin, Bo Hill and Amy Schimke for answering so many questions for me and their great advice. We'd like to thank Burns Ranch for taking such great care of Jesse and holding our hand this first year (and probably second year too). This is a new road for all of us, but we're very excited to see where it takes us!

BARREL RACING TIP

Lateral Flexion is one of the first things you should teach your horse. First on the ground and then again when you first get on. After your horse learns this basic move, initiate a quick reminder prior to every ride.

To teach this from the ground, I normally use a snaffle bit. I stand to the side adjacent to your stirrup. I use the same technique I would use if I were on their back. However, the difference being would be a pull that originates much lower and farther from the horse than if you were in the saddle. The reason to start in this position is that it is easier for the horse to understand and accept. Once the horse understands what I want, I raise my hand up higher and closer toward the neck and horn to give them the same feel they would get if I were mounted.

The Pull: Move your hand down the rein toward their mouth (either side); you would apply some pressure to get a response from your horse. Be sure to have your opposing rein lose enough for the horse to give in the direction you are working on. If your horse gives slightly in a lateral position, you reward by releasing your rein pressure quickly, when you get the correct response. If he does not give, apply just enough pressure until they give,

even if it is ever so slightly. Each time you ask, ask them to bend in the lateral direction a little more each time. If you try to get it all at one time, some horses may get confused and become heavier or fight more opposed to becoming lighter. Once they learn this on the ground, this basic move becomes very easy when you are mounted.


When mounted, reach down the rein and start by moving your hand up their neck and away from their neck in the direction you are working. The more your horse understands what you want, you can move your hand closer to the neck and closer to your horn. After they completely understand, practice this basic move at least once every day. I normally mount up, sit for a moment, and then ask them to give in both directions, before I ride off. If one side is better, then work twice as much on the bad side until they feel the same in both directions. After that, practice both sides equally. Sometimes during my ride, if my horse needs a rest, I will practice at this time as well

The more they get to know this basic move, the less I practice it. I merely give it a test every day and prior to a competition.



CARE & MANAGEMENT OF THE GROWING FOAL NEWBORN – PART 1

This is the first of two articles on the young foal from birth to weaning. The purpose of the first article is to take a short journey from the separation of the umbilical cord through the first week of life. I touch on some of the important points of care and common problems you should be on the lookout for. One recurring theme is to observe the young foal carefully, and promptly discuss with your veterinarian any questions that come up. I advise my clients to be careful not to dive in to treat foals themselves unless they are confident in what they are doing. Sometimes well-meaning owners do more harm than good when they try to help their young foals.

Horse people intuitively know that the foal's first days of life are a critical time. This is an exciting and idyllic time for both foal and owner. Behind the scenes, every part of the young foal is developing rapidly and adjusting to life outside of the mare. The young foal's body systems are very fragile and sensitive during this period. Problems like diarrhea, colic and infected joints can progress rapidly in the young foal and quickly become life threatening if not treated appropriately. Improper management or nutrition may lead to irreversible problems.



In the growing foal, other problems like Developmental Orthopedic Disease (DOD) may be subtle and might go undetected if owners are not on the lookout for these problems. Good management and an understanding of the common problems that can arise in this age foal can help ensure that the young foal grows normally and reaches weaning strong and healthy.

It's 2 a.m. and with a final hard press from the mare, the newborn foal (a colt) lies near its mother in the clean, fresh straw. Its face is free of the placenta, and it is already trying to get its head up and roll on its chest.

It's best not to rush in unless you know there's a problem. The mare will get up in a minute and she will likely break the umbilical cord then, as nature intended. Cutting the umbilical cord sharp or too close to the foal's body can result in umbilical disease later. It's also not advisable to treat the umbilical stump with strong antiseptics. Many foals end up with umbilical infections from overzealous treatment of the umbelicus with strong antiseptics. I advise treating it once only, with a dilute antiseptic (chlorhexidine) solution.

It's 3 a.m. and after a dozen tries, the foal has gotten up on his own and he is now nursing.

Most baby foals are up within an hour of birth but some can take a little longer. They should nurse within another 30 to 60 minutes. The mare should have passed her placenta by now. Placentas are considered retained after three to four hours. A retained placenta is an emergency and must be resolved quickly by your veterinarian.

It's now 5 a.m., the foal has been up and nursed multiple times, and is now laying down sleeping.

The first day of the newborn's life is an eventful one. The normal pattern for the young foal is to nurse frequently and then nap, with much of the time spent sleeping.

It's 9 a.m. and the little colt is already bouncing around the stall and nursing vigorously. He stops, lifts his tail and seems to strain and push.

Constipation of the first manure (meconium) is common enough in the first day of life that many breeders give a routine enema. Meconium impaction is more common in colts than fillies. It is important to discuss this straining with your veterinarian when he or she arrives for the exam. He or she will likely give the foal an enema and ask you to monitor the foal closely to ensure that he continues to pass manure normally. Most minor impactions resolve with an enema.

Diarrhea is also a common problem in the newborn foal and is potentially fatal. It is usually caused by bacterial infection. If you notice diarrhea in the foal at one to five days of age, immediately communicate with your veterinarian.

Your veterinarian arrives and does a careful examination of mare, placenta and foal. The mare is healthy and the placenta is complete and normal. The veterinarian is now examining the foal, with an assistant handling the foal.

Foal handling is an art. It should be easy on the foal, mare and on the handlers. Gentle but firm and correct handling of the foal at this stage can pay great dividends later on. Many owners "imprint" their foals at this time. My suggestion to horse owners about imprinting is to do it right or don't do it at all. Poor handling can be stressful to the foal and might get your relationship off to a rocky start. There are plenty of books and resources out there that can help you learn the proper techniques of early foal handling.

I recommend a veterinary exam for every newborn foal. When the foal is 8-24 hours old, I do a careful examination of the mare, the placenta and the foal. In the foal exam, I look carefully at attitude and general health. I listen to its heart, lungs and abdomen. I inspect the umbilical stump, joints, mouth and eyes. I carefully examine the foal's legs. I do not believe in giving vaccinations, vitamins or antibiotics to newborn foals unless I know they are ill or are at risk for a problem.

Importantly, I take blood to check for antibody levels (IgG) that was absorbed from the first milk (colostrum). All foals must ingest good quality colostrum within the first hours of life. A change in the intestinal lining, called closure, takes place in the foal's intestine after 18 to 24 hours of life. After that, the foal can no longer absorb the colostrum's vital antibodies from its intestine. Failure to ingest

this antibody is called Failure of Passive Transfer (FPT). FPT is a common problem for foals and must be treated correctly and immediately. If the foal fails to nurse normally, it must ingest good quality colostrum from its dam or another mare by stomach tube or bottle within hours of birth. Failing that, it must be treated with intravenous plasma containing the necessary antibody. If the foal does not receive adequate antibody, it will be incapable of fighting disease and will usually not survive. Commercial colostrum supplements are no substitute for adequate colostrum.

Your veterinarian comments that your foal has flexor tendon laxity and mild angular limbs.

You had noticed earlier that his rear fetlocks seemed to sag almost to the ground and his toes come off the ground slightly. This is a very common problem in young foals. It can occasionally be serious but usually resolves quickly on its own, as the foal gains strength.

The opposite problem of the tendons being too "tight" is also fairly common. This is called flexural deformity and usually means that the affected joints are over-flexed, or too upright. The most common area for this problem is the lower limb, either the fetlock or the foot itself. It is important to discuss any limb problem with your veterinarian right away. Early and appropriate treatment is critical for getting good results.

Continue Thal...

"Angular limbs" is a term that refers to abnormal deviation of the foals limbs when viewed from the front or back. In the first few days of life, many normal foals have very crooked looking limbs. Your veterinarian can advise you as to what is normal and what is not. Most angular limb problems resolve on their own, but others require treatment and may involve stall confinement, splinting and even surgery. Surgical procedures mostly rely on impeding growth on one side of the limb while the other side continues to grow normally, thus straightening the limb. Within weeks, the bones of the lower limb stop growing in length and treatment may be impossible.





Foal - Angular Limb Deformity - After Surgical Correction




"Foal Heat Diarrhea" is a normal diarrhea that occurs in foals at one to two weeks of age. The mares' "foal heat" (the first heat after foaling) usually coincides with this period of foal diarrhea, however the diarrhea is probably not caused by the mare being in heat. Your veterinarian will likely ask you to just watch the foal and ensure that he continues to nurse well and act normal. You may also be told to smear some Vaseline or A&D ointment under the foal's tail and down the hind end to prevent scalding. Usually this diarrhea resolves spontaneously. Occasionally, a foal has persistent or more serious diarrhea. In those cases, I try to diagnose a cause and start treatment.

We have taken a short journey with our newborn foal from birth through his first week. In Part 2 of this article, we'll follow him along through the period from two weeks to weaning.


Ryann will head to the Lance Graves Pro Classic, The Patriot, Diamonds and Dirt, and eventually to Ft. Smith.

LONG IN THE TOOTH

THE WAY OF THE HORSES By Eleanor Blazer © 2016

Is your horse getting a little long in the tooth?....this old saying usually means the horse (or person) is getting old. But even young horses can have teeth that are too long or have sharp points. It's very important to understand how horses' teeth change as they mature.

Horses' teeth do not grow – they erupt. The entire permanent equine tooth is below the gum line. As a horse chews the exposed surface of the tooth is worn away. The tooth emerges (erupts) maintaining the needed length. By the time the horse is a senior only a stub will be visible...if there is any tooth remaining.

A foal's teeth will start to erupt within a week of birth. The first set to appear will be the four incisors located in the middle – two on the top and two on the bottom. The second set (intermediate) will appear a week or two later, with the third set (corner incisors) appearing at about six months of age. There will be a total of 12 teeth in the front. The premolars will also erupt at about two or three weeks of age. There are three on each side – top and bottom - for a total of 12 teeth in the back.

Over the next four plus years the permanent teeth will erupt. The erupting permanent teeth will push the shorter rooted baby teeth out. The baby teeth are sometimes called caps because they sit on top of the permanent tooth until they shed.

At the same time 12 more additional permanent molars will erupt. An adult mare usually has 36 permanent teeth. An adult male will usually have 40. Males usually develop canine teeth...adding to the number of teeth present. Some mares will also show canine teeth, but are small and short rooted.

Young growing horses need to have their teeth examined regularly. There are times when the cap may not shed or becomes lodged in the gum. The cap will need to be removed.

The lower jaw of the horse is slightly narrower than the upper. The lower jaw moves back and forth - grinding the lower teeth against the upper teeth during the chewing process. The surface of the teeth is worn away and eruption occurs in order to maintain the needed length. As long as there is full lateral movement of the lower jaw, and the diet is "horse friendly" the teeth should wear properly; but that is not always the case.

Wild horses with poor teeth died and did not reproduce. But most breeding programs do not take into consideration the structure of the jaw and quality of the teeth. Processed feeds now allow horses with genetic tooth defects to lead productive and useful lives. In most cases the owners are not aware of a genetic tooth problem.

Most domesticated horses, diets are not natural. Eating hay from a manger instead of grazing does not allow the incisors (front teeth) to be worn down. The molars are still being worn away, but not the incisors. Eventually the molars will not meet properly because the incisors are too long.

The feeding of grain and processed commercial products instead of forage can also affect the molars. When a horse eats long stem fiber – hay or grass, he grinds the material with a big wide lateral movement of the lower jaw. This allows the lower teeth to grind against the upper teeth and wear evenly. If grains, chopped forage, pellets and processed feeds make up the majority of the diet, the horse chews with a short quick lateral movement. The teeth do wear evenly and long points will develop.


Another cause of a long tooth is a missing corresponding tooth. There is nothing for the remaining tooth to wear against; but it will continue to erupt and cause chewing problems.

If you want your horse to become *long in the* tooth because of age, be sure to make regular dental appointments for him. An equine dentist or veterinarian can file the long tooth or point, allowing the horse to chew properly.




