## JAMES BARNES

**WHERE'S MY SOXX ("Cartier")** is an own daughter of BHR Frenchie Socks out of Picabo Gold which is by Dash Ta Fame. I purchased Cartier as a long yearling from Amanda Kay of Joaquin, Texas. Her sister, LeAnn Kay Rafferty, is the one who got the ball rolling and all the plans worked out for me to be able to purchase her. Cartier has been different from day one. She was a little troublesome to break as she was very opinionated and waspy. She took a little more time to get broke before she was ready for barrels. But when she finally was broke enough to begin, she was a natural on the barrels. She makes me look good and as if I know what I'm doing and I thank her for that. She's made training barrel horses fun again. However, she doesn't like to slow work at all. Trotting her through the barrels or slow loping her through is the most unorthodox and out of control pattern that you will probably ever witness. Cartier just wants to go fast! She's been that way from day one!! She is all business. I've laughed and told my friends, that by the time the Old Fort Days Futurity gets here, her warm up will probably be on a lunge line. She's just that enthusiastic about running barrels and doing her job.

### LUCKY DOG FUTURITY...

When I arrive at a futurity, I always expect to perform my very best, but sometimes it's just not your time. I didn't have the week I wanted at the LG Pro Classic in Kinder, LA from my horse struggling with the ground and not firing on all fours. So after Kinder, I came home and adjusted our daily routine to prepare for a better week at the Lucky Dog Futurity. My initial game plan was to make the best run possible for the day and see where the cards fell.

My first run was far from perfect. One thing I could say that went right in my first run was that Cartier went FAST! I've always said if you are going to go past a barrel, you better be doing it fast; and Cartier did just that in the first go. She basically went to the wall at the first barrel and didn't turn 2 or 3 very well either. She ended up in the middle of the pack with a 15.4.

After my first go run, I knew I had to make a change once again. My horse was definitely firing again, but I had lost my rate and turn. Going into the Diamonds and Dirt Futurity next week, I knew I needed to make a change because I had more run than turn at this point. So, I decided to take her tie down off and put her exercise bit on for the 2nd go, and needed to hold her up in the alley a little longer before I asked her to run. She warmed up extremely well. I felt extremely confident in my decision by that time. I just wanted to clean my turns up from the first go and hope she clocked. I held her to the mouth of the alley since it was a long distance from alley to timer and to the first barrel. As I asked her to go, she ran hard to the first and I could feel her dropping in for it. At that point, I knew she was focused and dialed into the first barrel, so I left her alone and she had a good first barrel. She always turns the first barrel flatter and stiffer than the other 2 barrels. She flew across the arena to the 2nd barrel. I've never felt her run that hard across the pen, and when I dropped to my horn, she immediately came back to my hands and turned great. Going to the 3rd, I had to help her 'a touch' because I didn't feel her commit to the barrel. But once I asked her she immediately responded.

### PRODUCERS...

The Lucky Dog crew is by far the best producers going right now in my opinion. They are kind, professional, organized, and respectful to all contestants whether they are futurity trainers, derby, youth, or open riders. I think all producers should attend and do an internship of a Lucky Dog Show before producing a show. Lucky dog sets the bar high and prevails!! The ground crew led by John Laws is by far the best in the business. The ground stays consistent, safe, and fair. When I attend a Lucky Dog Show, the ground is the least of my worries unlike several other futurities.

### TRAINING...

I've struggled the last 2 months with my timing and my horse gaining more confidence; I was mentally in a slump. I was so frustrated with myself because

Cartier deserved a better jockey. I'm so thankful that I made the changes and stepped my game up to help rebuild my confidence. No matter what obstacles we face, we all must continue to work harder and harder to achieve and to overcome.

Training and running futurities has always been something I wanted to do since I started running barrels when I was 12 years old. I can remember reading the Barrel Horse News about Cody Bauserman and Likely Fuel, Bo Hill and He is Slipping, Jamey Hunt on Bellefous, Troy Crumrine on Sissys Little Coin and HL Sprite. Those are my idols--phenomenal horseman and trainers. I ran my first futurity in 2001 on a halter bred horse I bought and trained for \$1200. I was absolutely clueless with bloodlines as I didn't come from a rodeo or barrel racing family. Everything I've learned has been self-taught by reading, talking to, and watching other trainers during their runs, or in the warm up arena. Due to college and studying to become a mathematician, I didn't try futurities again until around 2009. I gave up teaching juvenile delinquents and started training full time around 2010. Some days, I questioned my decision when I'm riding a stubborn colt. I placed a couple of times, but I didn't win anything big until 2011 aboard Susan Gibson's good mare, Cash Not Corona, when I won the Old Fort Days Futurity Reserve Championship. I've placed but never actually won a futurity until now. I'm still excited and on cloud 9!!!

#### ADVICE...

Never give up! Keep trying and working hard. If you want to train or ride futurity horses, buy pedigree and go ride with the top trainers that are winning. That is so important. Mark Bugni and I are very good friends. He's helped me tremendously in my training and daily routines. I owe a ton of thanks to Mark! You will win some, but you will lose a lot more. Be prepared for good days and bad days, because not every run or every day is perfect.

#### THANK YOU...

I am very thankful to a lot of people...As I said earlier, I owe a ton of thanks to Mark Bugni who has helped me tremendously with my training skills and my mental preparation and confidence. Mark and Jackie Jatzlau are the 2 most positive trainers and jockeys that I know. Their horses can hit all 3 barrels and they are going to find everything positive that their horse did. They always focus on the positive and never the negative. Bo Hill has helped me to strive to be a quieter rider and never allow my horses to second guess what their job is. As she says, "never lie to your horse." I'm still trying to do the Bo Hill one hand deal or even better, turn completely loose of the reins and have my horse still turn the barrel. I haven't mastered that skill yet! Cody Bauserman was the very first top trainer for me to visit and ride with. He was first to introduce himself to me at a show and to offer advice and help. I think Cody was more excited about my *win* than I was myself. Cody has ice running through his veins, and is extremely confident in his training. Riding with Cody periodically has taught me how to be mentally tough just by watching his routine at home and at a show. When he goes down the alley, he's there to WIN, not place. It's unbelievable the confidence he has and I admire him for it. I would like to thank Dr. Josh Harvey and crew with Outlaw Equine for keeping Cartier sound and healthy. 5 Star Saddle Pads provides me with the best all natural wool pad on the market--Cartier's back is never sore and my saddle never slides. I also have to thank OE Nutraceuticals for their amazing support of the OE Align and OE Clean. Equi-sure helps keep Cartier drinking and eating while on the road away from home. And of course, Geoffrey Litton and Tonda Collins of Equi-Resp for the amazing nebulizer.

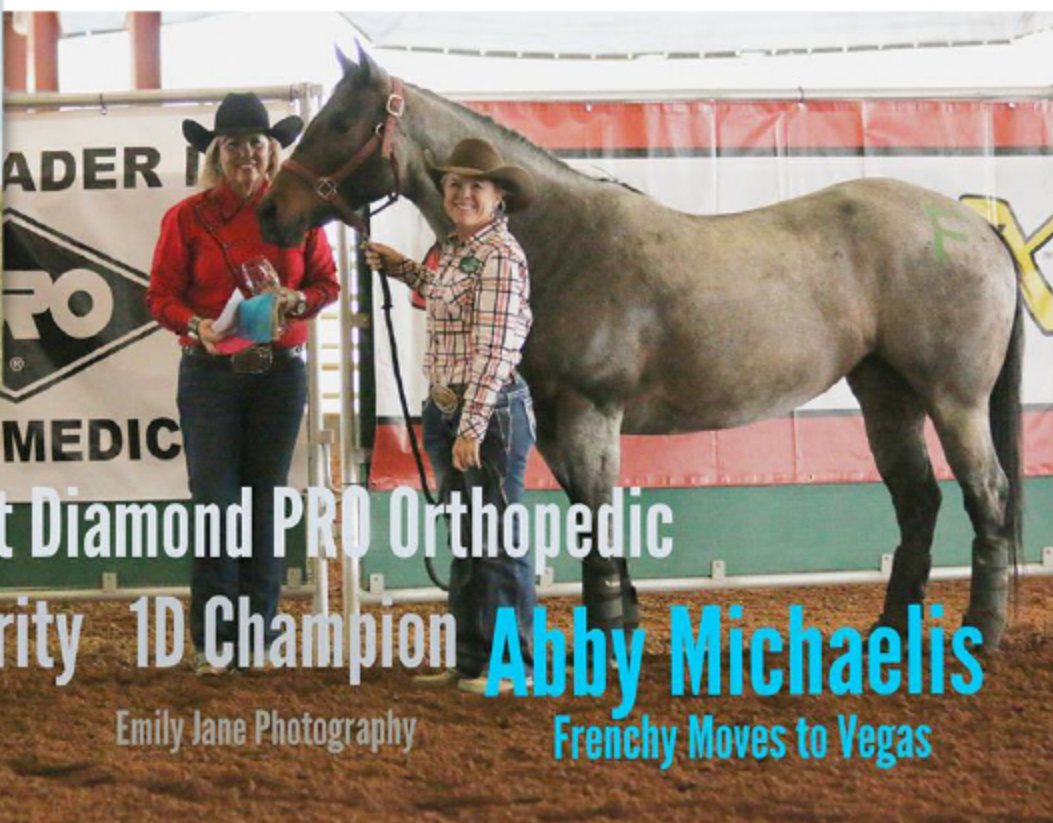

## 'TWISTED SISTER'...

We raised Frenchy MovesToVegas aka 'Twisted Sister'. I had French StreaktoVegas in training and my rodeo mare, Heavenly Days had to have some time off. I kept fighting my head on whether to breed her. I hauled her to Outback Stallion Station when I had to take Streak to be collected; they checked her and she was ready to breed that day! So it seemed like it was meant to be.

Her sire, French StreaktoVegas was extremely cowy. My Dad roped on him to keep him in shape and sharp. We thought he might cross well on Pearl Jam (Heavenly Days). Pearl was pretty hot so we were hoping Streak's personality would help.

Twisty has always had a lot of go. Her mother was the same--very intense. I just always hoped she would put her energy in the right place. She's always loved the barrels but despises slow work, so I just try to keep her happy and as relaxed as I can. Her love of the barrels definitely comes from her sire.

As far as any quirks she has, she is so sensitive in her mouth and its magnified at a barrel race or when she gets nervous. Quoting a good friend of mine "She's a pill with her mouth, but she's a winner." Lol

As far as a training tip, I don't do a ton of drills, but I do like working my horses the same direction around all three barrels. It seems to help them find a comfortable spot around a barrel.

Gear, supplements and therapies I use are: Elliot Spur Up 04/07, Tami Semas Saddle, Depaolo Equine Concepts Essential Vitamins, Silver Lining Herbs, 3MB Specialties, Lubrisyn, Back On Track products, Equine Evaluations Adjustment Max Haylett, and Canyon's Edge Equine.

Before entering my first futurity, I actually hauled her quite a bit during her four year old year. I like my colts to have as many good experiences as possible and see the sites.

Twisty's first futurity was in California in December. She did ok, won a little Future Fortunes money but I felt like I burned my good run in time-onlys. That was a learning curve for both of us. I had entered her in the Arizona futurities in January but she rolled into a fence so we spent the month healing up.

At the Desert Diamond...Honestly, I was a little nervous that first round. Twisty isn't one you can make a lot of practice runs on and I was just hoping she felt good. I went into it telling myself I would just be tickled with smooth runs and a good experience for her...I've gone to a few other Desert Diamond barrel races and they are always very well run and super friendly. Sue and Toni do a fabulous job!

For 2017, I've entered the Sand Cup, Walla Walla, and Idaho futurities. We will see how those go and then make plans. My end goal is for her to still like her job and be successful at it.

I'd like to thank my family and friends--your support system plays such a huge role. Thank you to my husband for supporting me and my passion, my Mom for being the best mentor a girl could ask for and my Dad for trying to engrain in me "It's not the bit, it's the hands behind it." And, a huge thank you to my sponsor and vet, Jim and Renate Dorenkamp at Canyon's Edge Equine for always being just a call away.

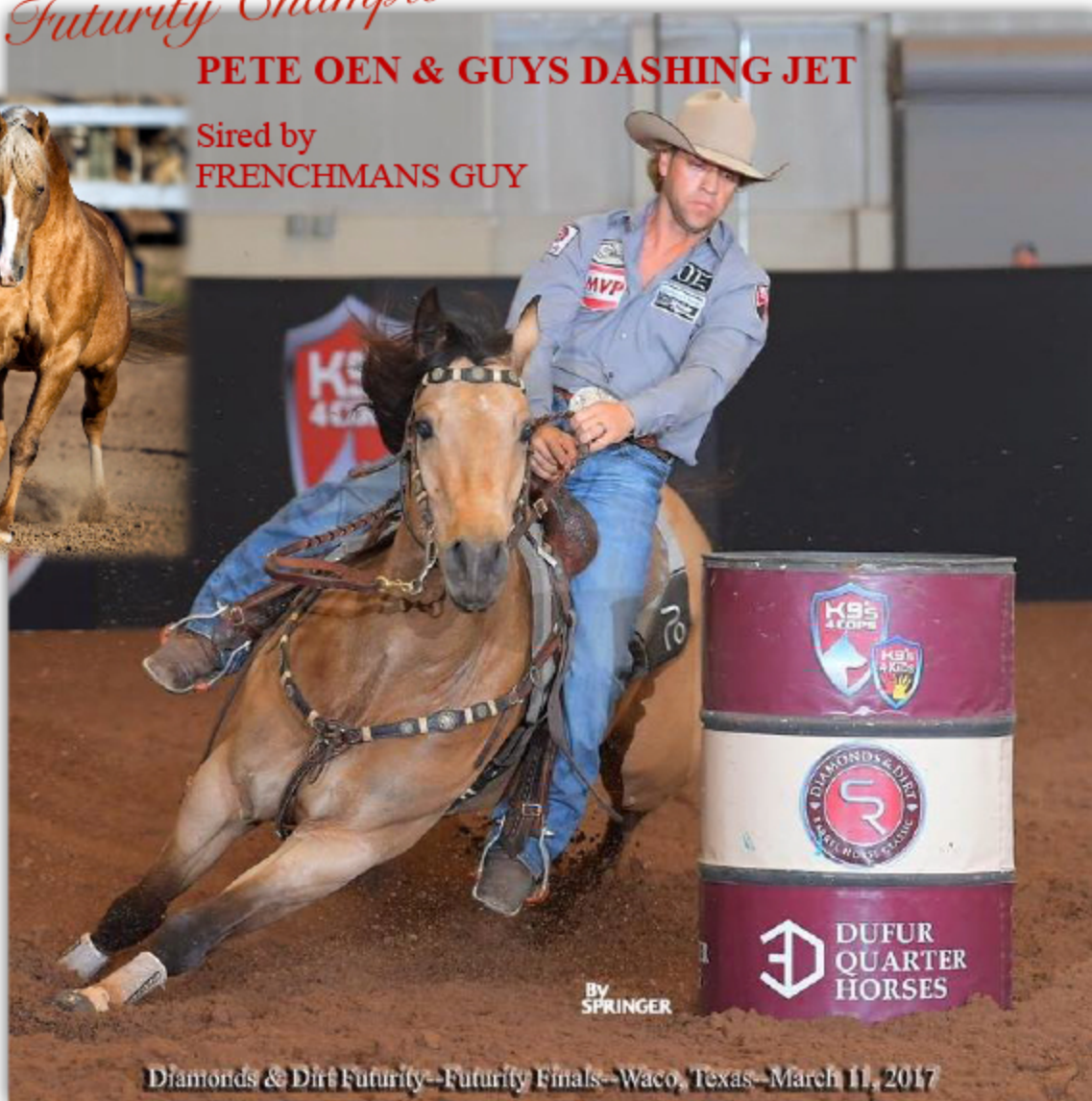

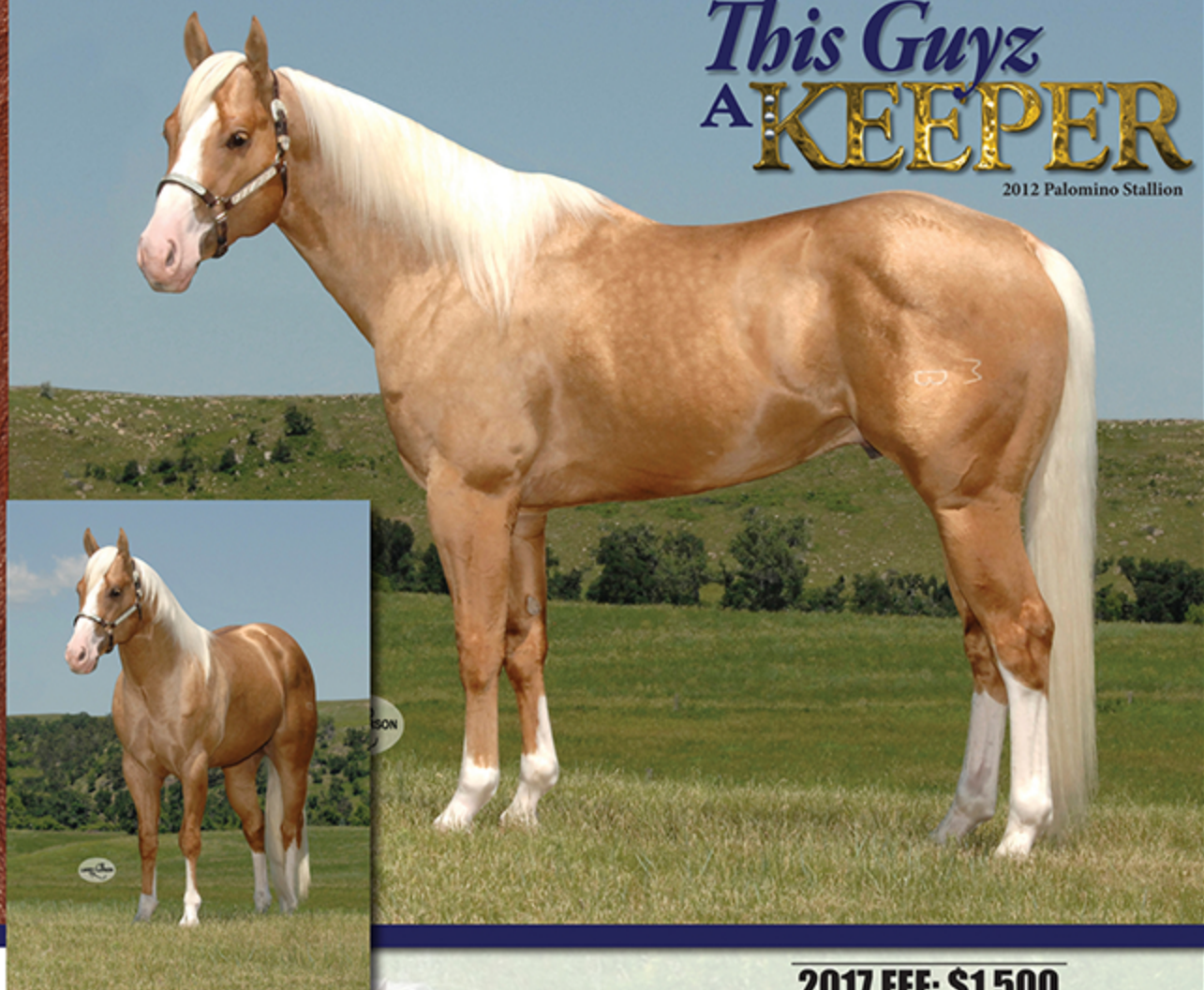

## CARE & MANAGEMENT OF THE GROWING FOAL NEWBORN – PART 1

This is the first of two articles on the young foal from birth to weaning. The purpose of the first article is to take a short journey from the separation of the umbilical cord through the first week of life. I touch on some of the important points of care and common problems you should be on the lookout for. One recurring theme is to observe the young foal carefully, and promptly discuss with your veterinarian any questions that come up. I advise my clients to be careful not to dive in to treat foals themselves unless they are confident in what they are doing. Sometimes well-meaning owners do more harm than good when they try to help their young foals.

Horse people intuitively know that the foal's first days of life are a critical time. This is an exciting and idyllic time for both foal and owner. Behind the scenes, every part of the young foal is developing rapidly and adjusting to life outside of the mare. The young foal's body systems are very fragile and sensitive during this period. Problems like diarrhea, colic and infected joints can progress rapidly in the young foal and quickly become life threatening if not treated appropriately. Improper management or nutrition may lead to irreversible problems.



In the growing foal, other problems like Developmental Orthopedic Disease (DOD) may be subtle and might go undetected if owners are not on the lookout for these problems. Good management and an understanding of the common problems that can arise in this age foal can help ensure that the young foal grows normally and reaches weaning strong and healthy.

***It's 2 a.m. and with a final hard press from the mare, the newborn foal (a colt) lies near its mother in the clean, fresh straw. Its face is free of the placenta, and it is already trying to get its head up and roll on its chest.***

It's best not to rush in unless you know there's a problem. The mare will get up in a minute and she will likely break the umbilical cord then, as nature intended. Cutting the umbilical cord sharp or too close to the foal's body can result in umbilical disease later. It's also not advisable to treat the umbilical stump with strong antiseptics. Many foals end up with umbilical infections from overzealous treatment of the umbel-icus with strong antiseptics. I advise treating it once only, with a dilute antiseptic (chlorhexidine) solution.

***It's 3 a.m. and after a dozen tries, the foal has gotten up on his own and he is now nursing.***

Most baby foals are up within an hour of birth but some can take a little longer. They should nurse within another 30 to 60 minutes. The mare should have passed her placenta by now. Placentas are considered retained after three to four hours. A retained placenta is an emergency and must be resolved quickly by your veterinarian.

***It's now 5 a.m., the foal has been up and nursed multiple times, and is now laying down sleeping.***

The first day of the newborn's life is an eventful one. The normal pattern for the young foal is to nurse frequently and then nap, with much of the time spent sleeping.

***It's 9 a.m. and the little colt is already bouncing around the stall and nursing vigorously. He stops, lifts his tail and seems to strain and push.***

Constipation of the first manure (meconium) is common enough in the first day of life that many breeders give a routine enema. Meconium impaction is more common in colts than fillies. It is important to discuss this straining with your veterinarian when he or she arrives for the exam. He or she will likely give the foal an enema and ask you to monitor the foal closely to ensure that he continues to pass manure normally. Most minor impactions resolve with an enema.

Diarrhea is also a common problem in the newborn foal and is potentially fatal. It is usually caused by bacterial infection. If you notice diarrhea in the foal at one to five days of age, immediately communicate with your veterinarian.

***Your veterinarian arrives and does a careful examination of mare, placenta and foal. The mare is healthy and the placenta is complete and normal. The veterinarian is now examining the foal, with an assistant handling the foal.***

Foal handling is an art. It should be easy on the foal, mare and on the handlers. Gentle but firm and correct handling of the foal at this stage can pay great dividends later on. Many owners "imprint" their foals at this time. My suggestion to horse owners about imprinting is to do it right or don't do it at all. Poor handling can be stressful to the foal and might get your relationship off to a rocky start. There are plenty of books and resources out there that can help you learn the proper techniques of early foal handling.

I recommend a veterinary exam for every newborn foal. When the foal is 8-24 hours old, I do a careful examination of the mare, the placenta and the foal. In the foal exam, I look carefully at attitude and general health. I listen to its heart, lungs and abdomen. I inspect the umbilical stump, joints, mouth and eyes. I carefully examine the foal's legs. I do not believe in giving vaccinations, vitamins or antibiotics to newborn foals unless I know they are ill or are at risk for a problem.

Importantly, I take blood to check for antibody levels (IgG) that was absorbed from the first milk (colostrum). All foals must ingest good quality colostrum within the first hours of life. A change in the intestinal lining, called closure, takes place in the foal's intestine after 18 to 24 hours of life. After that, the foal can no longer absorb the colostrum's vital antibodies from its intestine. Failure to ingest

this antibody is called Failure of Passive Transfer (FPT). FPT is a common problem for foals and must be treated correctly and immediately. If the foal fails to nurse normally, it must ingest good quality colostrum from its dam or another mare by stomach tube or bottle within hours of birth. Failing that, it must be treated with intravenous plasma containing the necessary antibody. If the foal does not receive adequate antibody, it will be incapable of fighting disease and will usually not survive. Commercial colostrum supplements are no substitute for adequate colostrum.

***Your veterinarian comments that your foal has flexor tendon laxity and mild angular limbs.***

You had noticed earlier that his rear fetlocks seemed to sag almost to the ground and his toes come off the ground slightly. This is a very common problem in young foals. It can occasionally be serious but usually resolves quickly on its own, as the foal gains strength.

The opposite problem of the tendons being too "tight" is also fairly common. This is called flexural deformity and usually means that the affected joints are over-flexed, or too upright. The most common area for this problem is the lower limb, either the fetlock or the foot itself. It is important to discuss any limb problem with your veterinarian right away. Early and appropriate treatment is critical for getting good results.

Continue Thal...

“Angular limbs” is a term that refers to abnormal deviation of the foals limbs when viewed from the front or back. In the first few days of life, many normal foals have very crooked looking limbs. Your veterinarian can advise you as to what is normal and what is not. Most angular limb problems resolve on their own, but others require treatment and may involve stall confinement, splinting and even surgery. Surgical procedures mostly rely on impeding growth on one side of the limb while the other side continues to grow normally, thus straightening the limb. Within weeks, the bones of the lower limb stop growing in length and treatment may be impossible.

“Foal Heat Diarrhea” is a normal diarrhea that occurs in foals at one to two weeks of age. The mares’ “foal heat” (the first heat after foaling) usually coincides with this period of foal diarrhea, however the diarrhea is probably not caused by the mare being in heat. Your veterinarian will likely ask you to just watch the foal and ensure that he continues to nurse well and act normal. You may also be told to smear some Vaseline or A&D ointment under the foal’s tail and down the hind end to prevent scalding. Usually this diarrhea resolves spontaneously. Occasionally, a foal has persistent or more serious diarrhea. In those cases, I try to diagnose a cause and start treatment.

We have taken a short journey with our newborn foal from birth through his first week. In [Part 2](#) of this article, we’ll follow him along through the period from two weeks to weaning.

# ICHTHAMMOL – THE WONDER OINTMENT

Several million years ago horses grazed on plants that would be the basis of an amazing ointment. Known as ichthammol, black ointment or drawing salve, it is used to treat wounds, skin conditions and abscesses affecting descendants of these early horses. Ichthammol ointment is derived from sulfur-rich oil shale, a type of rock which is made up of organic material. After being mined and distilled, the resulting substance is dark reddish-brown to black color with a tar-like odor.

The anti-inflammatory, anti-bacterial and anti-fungal properties of ichthammol offset its appearance and smell. Ichthammol can be used to treat minor cuts or abrasions, rainrot, insect bites, scratches (mud fever, greasy heel), and sunburn. Applied down the midline of the underbelly it can help protect the sensitive area from insects, while soothing the itching and treating the bites. Water soluble, it can be washed off easily, though the smell can linger. The most recognized use is as a drawing salve. Ichthammol helps soften the tissue, reduces swelling and increases blood circulation, which may aid in the “drawing” of the infection or splinter. It is often used to help draw an abscess out of a hoof.

The United States Department of Health and Human Services, National Toxicity Program, states ammonium sulfobituminat (ichthammol) as having no toxicity levels. When compared to wound medications containing nitrofurazone, ichthammol is safer for both the horse and caretaker. Nitrofurazone has been shown to create carcinogenic activity in mice, resulting in the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and the Bureau of Veterinary Drugs in Canada to require labeling stating nitrofurazone must not be used on animals intended for food.



Nitrofurazone products also have cautionary statements on the labels stating some people may have adverse reactions to the ointment, and gloves should be worn.

When purchasing ichthammol beware of look-alike products. If the ointment lacks the strong bituminous tar-like smell it is not ichthammol. The ingredients will probably be vegetable based.

Also avoid products called “black salve” (Cansema). These products may contain bloodroot, crushed ash, chaparral, DMSO (dimethyl sulfoxide – an industrial solvent) and other ingredients. Often advertised as “treating cancer”, the FDA has banned the sale of black salve for that purpose. These products can be caustic, resulting in bad burns and scarring.

Despite the name confusion - black ointment, drawing salve or ichthammol – every equine medicine chest should have a jar. In time, you and your horse will learn to love the smell!
