DARCEE SHEPHERD

The weekend of the SW was a busy weekend. I was entered in Las Vegas Friday afternoon for the Helldorado Days rodeo. My rodeo horse has to have a buddy, so my mare Two Rubles went with. We didn't make it back for exhibitions runs and had to check her in Saturday morning. I was a little worried about the amount of time she had been hauled and hoped that it wasn't going to take anything out of her. Salina is close to home, so she had run

there all spring and I wasn't worried about her knowing that pen or needing exhibitions. Since it is close to home, I chose to drive home and keep the horses there. I feel like that helps them rest and feel their best.

Her first run felt really good. She wanted to play in her warm up, which is usually when she works. She ran a 15.973 which was 6th in the open futurity (1 hole out of placing) and 4th in the breeders for \$498. She also won

the open futurity (1 hole out of placing) and 4th in the breeders for \$498. She also won the 2D that day in the open (\$793). After having a good first day, I just wanted to make sure she stayed as solid and consistent as she had been all year. She felt a little flat the second morning when I warmed her up, so she kind of surprised me with how hard she ran. She has started to find her run and get more confident running to the first barrel. On Sunday, she left hard in the alley and was really running to the first. She hung a little on the back side of the first, but ran hard the rest of the way. She always pins her ears and tries so hard and runs so honest up into her turns. I was really excited when I heard my time. She ran a 15.641 to win the second go of the open and breeders futurity. That run also was the fast time of the futurity and clinched her the win (in both the open and breeders) as well as placed 8th in the 1D. All told she won \$5,372 for the weekend; \$4,400 from the futurity. This win was very exciting for me. It was my first futurity win, which makes it very special to me. I look up to these women who ride and train colts year in and year out, so to be able to stand with them in the winners picture was very exciting.

TWO RUBLES

We call her "Dee". Her sire is Twoforthedough, who stands at South Valley Large Animal Clinic Intermountain Equine Reproductive Center. He is by First Down Dash and out of Hemps Folly. He is a full brother to Dashing Folly an AQHA world champion race horse. Twoforthedough was also bred by Bob Burt, who is the breeder/owner of Dash Ta Fame. Her mother is A Societys Lass. She is by Society Road, and out of a Rocket Wrangler/Streakin Six mare. Her mother's side has had some really nice barrel horses in our area over the years. I found her sire the first year that they did the stallion incentive at the Southwest Desert Classic. I love Hempen' horses and actually bred 2 mares to him before buying Dee, hoping for fillies.... I got 2 horse colts. I sold one but the other who is coming 2 will be my next colt. I really feel like her sire has been over looked.

I bought Dee in November of her 3 year old year. I didn't know a ton about her up until the fall of her 2 year old year. She was bred by Jay Pitcher. She had a few outs on the track; nothing real impressive. The people who I bought her from took her to my brother-in-law to put the first 60 days on her after they got her. They spent the next year riding her, mostly just getting her broke. We found her when they put her up for sale on our local classified site. I called my brother-in-law, Kiley Shepherd and we talked about her. I also visited with my friend, Kyle McEntire, who knew her bottom side. I was encouraged to buy her, so we made plans to try her. I really liked her from the get go; I liked how she moved and felt. Since I live in Utah, and weather isn't always the easiest to

train in during the winter, I mostly rode her when I could that first winter, not really worried about barrel work until the spring of her 4 year old year. From the moment we got her, if the trailer left the house, she was on it. She went everywhere with me! I changed a few things on her with her training to make her more my style, but she has been so easy the whole way. She took right to the barrels. I only did a handful of exhibitions on her last fall and she was clocking in the 1 & 2D's so I felt pretty good about where she was at. She's always wanted to work and try really hard for me.

She never really has had any set backs since I've had her (minus a double abscess the week before we left for Walla Walla). She is very business minded, and has just always wanted to work. I think the most exciting thing is how consistent she has been. She placed 7th in the Salty Dash Futurity, was 16th at the Valley Girls in the Open and placed 11th I think in the breeders, she was also 7th at the UBRA & Idaho Barrel futurities. I couldn't ask a colt to work any more consistent than she has. It hasn't mattered the set up, she has always tried to go in and do her job.

I ride her in a Martin Racer saddle, with a corrector pad. I use polo wraps all the way around with Classic Equine ProTech bell boots. Her bit is a bit that I didn't like, so my husband modified it for me; he makes all my bits for me. It is a lifter type, 3 piece, copper-wrapped bit. She gets soft

rides in the trailer, Sore No More, I will mud, ice or use green cool on her legs after a run. She gets massages and chiropractic work as needed. I use a Back on Track or MagnaCu blanket on her (depending on temperatures) as well. We've recently added Flexineb treatments.

The Southwest Desert Classic is one of 2 pens I consider my home pen. It is held at the Blackhawk Arena in Salina UT. The Blackhawk is a great facility. It has a covered warm up, plenty of stalls and parking. The ground there stays consistent and safe. It is 40 minutes away from my house, so I'm very comfortable in that arena. Paul and Vickie Solomonson and their crew do a great job. They are very kind and want us to be able to get our best runs. It is always one of my favorite races to go to; I don't think I've missed it yet.

My goals haven't changed since the start of the year. When we started the year, we sat down and picked the futurities that we felt were "musts" then we looked at "maybe's". I have limited time off of work (teaching 6th grade), so I can't make everything. I will continue to go to the ones we picked, but my end goal is to have a solid horse that I can rodeo on in the years to come. We will go to Dash For Dollars in Ogden, UT, in June. I'm planning on the Parker-Wood in September and Western States in October. Most of my summer will be spent at the rodeos; she will be run at a few I think will fit her.

I couldn't do what I do without the support of my husband and family. My husband, Casey, does so much for me, and so does my little boy. He's always there to help, video, builds my bits, etc. I depend on him a lot. My brother-in-law, Kiley Shepherd, who shoes, massages and starts my horses is also a huge part of my success. I have awesome vets, Dr. Charlie Heaton & Dr. David Wolfe. They take such great care of my horses. It takes a village!

TRAINING TIP...

First thing, your foundation is so important. I don't think you can get very far if you don't have the basics on your horse. The second thing, listen to your horse. If your horse doesn't need the drills and pattern work, don't do it. On my mare, less is more. We hardly ever tune on her; mostly she just long trots and gets rode out on the mountain (I'm lucky enough to live on a mountain bench with lots of pastures to ride in). The final thing, be as consistent as possible. Don't get to a race and change how you ride; trust what you've done at home and your horse to do their jobs.

Winning this futurity was probably the proudest moment I've had as a trainer. I've had a lot of nice horses but 'Leroy' has been a special story from day one so it makes it a little more exciting for me.

Leroy is a bit of a nervous colt and tries so hard he can scare himself sometimes. I really didn't want to enter the futurities because I was so worried I'd be pushing him too hard too soon. Leroy has shown me so much of his potential from day one that I decided the last minute to enter and just see what happened. Going into the first round I just told myself to ease him through and let him do his thing. If he needed help, help him and if not just let him work. It never feels like he's loping but all anyone said after the first round was "he loped and still won



6th". I was nervous going into the second round and he felt it. He was pretty anxious and I didn't really know what was going to happen. I just told myself the same thing as the first round and trusted my training in him. He fired so hard but stayed smooth and correct. He got away from me a little on the third and I had to grab an outside rein to get him by it but that was about the only thing I could fault him on.

THE YELLOW ROSE FUTURITY is a super well run production. The ground stayed the same all the way though both rounds. It was a very fun atmosphere and awesome people to be around. It was different from rodeos for sure but I really enjoyed it. The Watt family did a fantastic job!

LEROY...I was really busy riding outside horses the spring of Leroy's three year old year and didn't have the time to start him myself, so I sent him for 30 days to Glen Beverage, a cutting horse trainer from Australia that had moved to Alberta. Glen was really high on the colt when he was done with him. He did an outstanding job putting the foundation on him. I like my horses very broke and cutter style so it fit perfectly into my program to start him on barrels. With the set back of a major injury I didn't get to start him on barrels until mid September last fall. He was a natural from day one. He was all turn with natural rate and used himself so correctly from the very beginning. Andrea Udal, a futurity trainer from Saskatchewan, has had a big influence on my program and helped me a lot when I started Leroy. December 1st there is a jackpot called the Crack Out up here that was started as kind of a fun thing to see where our futurity horses are going to clock. I had never ran Leroy on a clock prior to that jackpot and he went in and won the futurity side pot

and 5th in the 1D. That kind of got my wheels turning that maybe I was right about how special he really is. I went slow all winter and took him to jackpots where he clocked in the top of the 1D nearly everywhere I went.

Leroy is a 2012 Brown Gelding. He is actually not registered due to a long list of things that just led me to not getting it done. However he is by a stud named, Blackgold Jack who is an own son of Dash Ta Fame out of a daughter of Easy Rumbo. Ironically my mom and I just bought Blackgold Jack a few months ago. I trained and futurity'd Leroy's mother years ago and I had always wanted to own her. Someone else ended up buying the mare and she just so happened to have this colt on our ranch; we knew we needed to own him the day he was born. He has been with me from the day he was weaned.

About two weeks after I got Leroy home, from having him started, he got in the wire and cut almost half of the inside hoof wall off his right front foot. He ended up being out for over a year. I shoe my own horses so in August of his 4 year old year I just started trial and error on shoeing him seeing if I could get him sound. I figured a few things out and started riding him. He still wears two different sizes of shoes on the front end but he's sound and the hoof wall is growing back so I try not to change what's working. I think it makes him even more special when you tell people he's not papered and wears two different sized shoes.

I use a Tami Semas saddle, Dave Elliot one-to-one short shank, CSI pad, Back On Track polo wraps on all four; Zesterra and Platinum Performance, Prairie West Horse Pellets and Back On Track and PHT magnets.

GOALS...

Like I said, futurities have never really been my focus or priority because I've always rodeo'd and wanted to have rodeo horses. A friend of mine kind of forced me into paying the late fees to enter these spring futurities before I get busy with rodeos. I guess I probably owe her for making me enter after winning it...lol!! My goals still haven't really changed. I will still focus on rodeos on my other two horses and Leroy will tag along and learn the ways of the road. He might get to run in a few 'slacks' here and there but my main focus is keeping him together and loving his job. He can be a little fractious so I want to keep his mind right and not overdo it. I entered the South Country Barrel Futurity here in a few weeks on him so we will see how that goes. I wouldn't mind trying to get to the futurities that I can with him, to give him a chance at the Canadian High point futurity horse this year.

THANK YOU so much to my mom and dad, (Annette & Danny Moore) and my grandpa, Gary Moore; they deserve so much thanks and credit for the breeding program we have and for getting me where I am today on great horses. Winning this futurity with Leroy is incredibly exciting with my mom and me just buying his sire, Blackgold Jack. I think he is going to bring a lot of success to a program my mom and I have been working on for a very long time. I will be hauling and running Blackgold Jack at a few rodeos to season him, so it will be a very fun year with the two of them in my trailer.

I also want to thank my sponsors: Prairie West Horse Pellets and Zesterra for being a part of my crew this year and helping us out on the road.

TRAINING TIP...

I think the most important thing on any horse, in any discipline, is having them broke first. I want a soft feel and light feet on a horse. If you have that foundation built before you start on barrels you will always have something to fall back on when they start making mistakes. Teaching them where to place their feet and how to control their body makes going around a barrel fairly simple for them. I do a LOT of stopping at my barrels and walking around the turns. I do tons of slow, slow, slow work. I also think going to the pasture and riding hills and getting out of an arena is so important especially on babies. Arenas bore me so I think they feel the same after awhile. I also like to rope on my colts. I think any sort of other job for them is crucial to keeping their minds right. If Leroy gets a little tight or pushy I'll go head the heel-o-matic on him and get his mind off running barrels and thinking of something else.

It's been such a fun and rewarding process to see hard work paying off with Leroy. There have been some ups and downs with him and that makes it all a little bitter sweet. There is no better feeling than raising and training your own horse and have him do what he's doing.







My runs for the futurity went really well. I just let "Smarty" go in and do her thing and go at her own pace. I was a little nervous going into Saturday's race because the night before at the warm up race we tipped the second barrel and she is not a barrel hitter. Saturday she cruised a 16.8 and held the lead until the very last rider. Sunday I had the same game plan--let her go at her own pace and stay out of her way. She felt smoother than the day before and clocked a 16.6; she ended up winning 2nd in the 1D Sunday as well. We won \$395 Saturday and \$402 on Sunday. I had no expectations of winning the futurity average. There were some amazing riders there with a lot more experience with futurity horses than myself. As far as the futurity, I have known Deven for years and he knows his ground. I have run at his place several times and never worry about ground conditions there.

SMARTY was born and raised at the Diamond S Ranch in Corcoran, CA. I had purchased a little 2 year old filly from my good friend Shelley Chico that came from the Diamond S Ranch and was smitten with her...Unfortunately she died while at the trainers a few months later. Heartbroken I searched for another one like her and one of my dearest friends, Carolyn Reeves found "Smarty" and even bargained the price down for me. Smarty is by Cool Smart and out of a Mr. Gunsmoke mare. She was very, very green when I got her. Anytime I would try to mount her she would spin away from me and was just fearful. I found the way to her heart with cookies and I think we are pretty good friends now. I call her my cookie monster. She requires cookies to cinch her up and gets cookies right after every run and when she gets back to the trailer. Smarty kind of just took to the barrels. I didn't take her to very many barrel race-just did a lot of slow work at home and took her to a few gymkhanas to do barrel time onlys. She just turned 4 the end of April and I was going to wait to futurity her until next year but Carolyn was going to futurity her baby she raised so I wanted to share the experience with her as having a futurity horse has been on both of our bucket lists.

I purchased Smarty on March 30th, 2016 so I only had her 9 months before her first competition. She used to be very fresh when I would first get on so I would lunge her just on her rein and any onlookers would



think she was crazy because she would buck like none other every time!! Ha Ha...then she would stop, come to me and I would get on and ride off like nothing had happened. It might have been a little embarrassing at times.

I ride in a dog bone snaffle at home and run her in a dogbone simplicity bit.

GIVING THANKS...

Well I have to thank my Momma; I'm almost 40 years old and she is still my biggest fan and supporter. I am so thankful for her and blessed to have her in my life. My mother actually purchased DSR Shameless for me. I keep saying I need to pay her back before she sells her out from under me. LOL

Training Tip...

Slow work, slow work and make it fun for them. 'Make the right thing easy and the wrong thing unpleasant' has been my motto for all my horses.

VAUNA WALKER...

Famous Goodbye Lane placed third in both goes of the futurity running a 17.574 on the first go and a 17.648 on the second go.

We call him Fletcher, and he is owned by Ruby Walker, who is my mother-in-law. My husband, Randy helps me ride and train the colts, and I find this to be an advantage since he knows the colts as well as I do. He often has input on putting together a run plan that helps it be successful. We all had high expectations for Fletcher because he has been running very consistently and getting a little bit more confident all the time. It was held at the Nampa Center indoor warm-up arena, a standard set, and we thought that he could run very well there with his speed being a huge benefit on the larger set and sandy ground. It is a central entry with a lot of room and a long run to the first barrel. I personally prefer a long run to the first barrel because it gives the colt time to get set up in good position for the turn. I rarely circle to start them, but Fletcher will sometimes start on the wrong lead if he is anxious, so since the alleyway was wide enough, I did a nice slow circle in it to help him relax and get on the right lead both runs.

It was a particularly good weekend because my filly, owned by Randy and I, placed fifth in the first go with a 17.802, second in the second go with a 17.526 and ended up placing fourth in the average. Her name is Famous Dark Horse by Dash Ta Fame and out of Show Me Your Hyde and sired by Darkelly. We call her Peach.

We always have a great time at the Idaho Barrel Futurity and have supported it for many years. They worked very hard to make the ground good, using the Black Widow and Kiser groomers. The ground is somewhat sandy and can get a little deep, but I thought they did well in their efforts to have it be consistent. The Nampa Center is a great facility and the producers of Idaho Barrel Futurity make good use of it.

FAMOUS GOODBYE LANE...

Fletcher had three outs on the track as a two-yearold, trained by Wes Smith of Weston, Idaho. We saw him race at Rupert, Idaho where he got out of the gate really late, but by the finish line he caught up and placed third. We were pretty excited because even though he didn't win the race it was evi-

dent that he could really run. In the fall, as a two year old, Cody Hyde rode him and then I spent a little time on him just to get to know him. I liked him immediately because he was so willing and nice to ride. I rode him out of the arena most of the fall and just got to know him.

We started him on the barrels the spring he was a three year old and it was fun because he felt so quick-footed and picked things up so easily. Probably the only frustration with him was that when we took him places, he would show his excitement by switching leads randomly during the warm-up circles as he looked at all the other horses. We soon learned that he was all business on pattern when I ran him, and he stayed on the correct leads. We just continued to patiently correct him during the warm up, doing exercises to keep his attention, and he has gotten much better.

I ride in Pozzi barrel saddles and I love how they feel to me and they fit the horse. I run Fletcher in an Ed Wright medium shank bit with a dog-bone in the mouth piece. We use Back-On-Track Boots and blankets and would like to thank our sponsors Mike and Cindy Holland @ Besthorsegear.com.

TRAINING TIP...

I like to just ride the colts and get to know them as two year olds and I don't want them going around barrels until they can do all the things I want for several reasons. It is really easy to hurt two year olds by working them in deep ground or asking too much of them at a young age. I want them to be in really good condition before I ask very much, again, to prevent possible injuries. I want them to flex, counter-arc at a lope, run with some speed, know their leads, etc. If they are having difficulty getting something, I want to get it sorted out away

from the barrel pattern. When I take them to their first time only runs I take it pretty slow until I am sure they can find the turn position I want. Sometimes if they are really excited by the loudspeaker and other horses, their first time only is just a long trot and I gradually ask them to get faster as they get used to performing under stress. I think if you are pushing them to run hard and they are really upset by all the confusion, it can cause them to make a mistake that can be hard to correct such as running past a barrel, getting too tight in the turns, etc.

Our plans include going to the Southwest Desert Classic Barrel Futurity in Salina, UT, Old Fort Days Futurity in Fort Smith, Red Desert Classic in Rock Springs, WY, and Dash For Dollars in Ogden, UT. Fletcher will have about a month break from racing from June to July during which we will trial ride and do other things to keep him conditioned but let him relax. We plan to run at the Glacier Chaser in Kalispell, MT, Parker-Wood Memorial in Heber City, UT, Copper Spring Ranch in Bozeman MT, the Western States Futurity in Ogden UT, and the BFA in Oklahoma City in December.

STREAKIN FAST FLASH worked better than he ever has at the Fresh Start Futurity. I knew going into the first round that 'Eddy' was feeling extremely well and that he was going to fire. All I needed to do was stay out of his way and let him do his job; he worked extremely well and won the first go. Going into the second round my game plan was to stay consistent and make the same run as the day before. The second round went even better, improving by 3 tenths and winning the second go and clocking that fastest time of the weekend. At the end of the weekend we had won both goes of the futurity and the average, winning \$1988.00.

Lucky Penny Productions has always gone above and beyond to make sure that the runners have the best ground as possible. I felt that the ground was very consistent and fast all weekend long. I would highly recommend any barrel race that is produced by Penny.

Streakin Fast Flash was raised on our place, owned by my parents Rick and Lisa Bruley and is sired by A Steak Of Fling. Eddy was the kind of horse that took a little work to get to run the barrels. But once he got the gist of it he was very easy to train and ride. The most important thing with Eddy is to try and stay relaxed because he is a very playful horse and sometimes it can be a little hard to put up with it. Because Eddy has had limited hauling, I still make sure that I get at least two exhibitions on him before I run so that he is able to see the inside of the area. Alysia Moe started him on the barrels. When I got him, he was working a very correct pattern at a lope and then I trained him from that point on.

Eddy was raised at my parents place in Willow Lake, South Dakota. Eddy's mom, Fancy Fanny Flasher, was never competed on herself but there were several horses of the same blood line that had proven themselves. Our family had owned several horses closely related to Fancy Fanny Flasher with a high rate of success in both the roping events and the barrel pen.

Streakin Fast Flash was a colt that didn't really think that he needed a job. But after two months of ranching with Colton Musick he was much more mature and ready to work. After being on the ranch with Colton we sent him to Alysia Moe to be started on the barrels. Alysia did an absolutely amazing job with him and Eddy hasn't stopped improving yet. He has been a very fun horse to ride and I can't wait to see what he is going to accomplish.

I ride Eddy in a short shank gag with a chain mouthpiece; it's what he has always liked the most and works the best in. We have a chiropractor work on Eddy when we feel that he might be getting sore We also have started to put a lot of time into stretching our horses regularly and have seen a great improvement in the way that they run.

The plan is to continue to haul to the futurities on the NRF Tour, and some of the local open races. We aren't going to run the legs off of him. We just want to keep him sound and make his career as long as it possibly can be.

GIVING THANKS...

I would like to thank my parents for everything that they do for me. And I would also like to thank all of my family and friends that are always there cheering for me during my runs.

TRAINING TIP...

I wouldn't say that I am a trainer but everything that I have learned about barrel racing has come from watching the people that are better than me and asking them questions. When you go to a barrel race spend your free time watching everyone else's runs. There is a lot you can learn from observing different styles and techniques in the barrel horse industry.

In the time trials I just wanted to make the top 40 to make the finals (goal was not to hit a barrel). But as I went too hard to the first barrel and ran right past it, I was afraid I had made too big of a mistake to get back. But boy did he turn his second two fast (thank goodness). We made the finals, so for two days all I could think was 'how am I going to turn my first barrel better.' The night of the finals he rode so calm in the back and down the alley, making my job a lot easier. So I didn't go full throttle to the first and made sure I got it turned; and it worked. I was proud of him; he did everything I asked of him that night. Like someone said, 'winning Ft Smith is on every trainer's bucket list.' So it really is exciting!!!! It's an excitement that you can't put into words...seems more like a dream.

RYON ROCKS

Ryon's Sire is Louisiana Senator and dam is Phoebe Ryon by Bill Ryon and she is out of Dashing Phoebe. Dashing Phoebe is why I purchased him and he was a deal at the BFA sale. Dale Rankin raised him and still owns his dam. Ryon was an easy horse to train. He really never had a bad day. He just never liked it when I changed his bit. He still is riding in a medium twist dog bone snaffle that I start all my colts in from the beginning. He never went to the race track like most of my colts and he had to learn to run, which is something I don't teach very well. Most of the time, I'm trying to get them to slow down and turn. Lol

ANY SETBACKS ALONG THE WAY?

Every horse and trainer has setbacks--it's how you handle those setbacks. Ryon has pulled over the

second barrel several times this year to win money. It wasn't until Stephanie Wheeler noticed he was picking up both back feet at the same time that I realized he was sore. So I went to Tryon Equine and we evaluated him until we figured it out, and got a game plan to fix the issue. This was just two weeks after he finished second at the Panty Raid Futurity.

WHAT TYPE OF BIT, SADDLE, THERAPIES, ETC. DO YOU USE?

He rides in a medium twist dog bone bit made by Carolina Bit. I ride him in a Double J Pro Elite wide tree. I like my Back On Track wraps but he takes them off (Lol) so he makes me do the old fashioned way...rolling and wrapping with standing bandages...which he also takes off. He can be a clown. I also use the salt water spa at Ft Smith. And he loves his Equi Resp.

OLD FORT DAYS FUTURITY...

We have been going there for so many years so we know what to expect when we get there.... advice for a newcomer is to find someone who has been there before and ask a lot of questions or call Cindy-she is a sweet lady that will be glad to answer your questions.


TRAINING TIP...

GROOMING AS MASSAGE

Grooming our horses serves a number of functions. It gets the dirt, dust and mud off, it improves circulation and the condition of skin and coat and helps warm up muscles before we ride. It also gives us a chance to spend personal time with our horses doing something they enjoy and gives us pleasure.

Simat Whipp, instructor of the online course, Equine Massage, says, "Adding some basic massage to the grooming session can improve your horse's comfort, movement and performance. Potential problems building in the muscles may also be detected."

As you groom your horse you may notice him flinch or drop away from pressure. If the muscle is tight or sore he may lean into or push back against the pressure, or he may be stiff and brace against your hand. A muscle in good condition will allow your horse to sway and move easily to pressure. Whipp cautions, "If your horse is not used to this kind of touch he may move around a little at first, but once he understands that the pressure helps him relax, he will start to lick and chew and enjoy the session."

So how can you make your grooming session into a massage session? Following are general guidelines.

Use a fairly stiff rubber (or plastic) curry comb unless your horse is very sensitive. Adjust your pressure for the horse's level of sensitivity, but use enough to get the horse to yield in its body and go with the pressure, but without causing obvious discomfort. Find a pressure that is suitable for your horse. You'll be riding a fine line between a pressure that is enough to get the horse's attention to the fact that you are doing something to its body, but not so much that the horse gets defensive. Watch for soft eyes, licking and chewing, as those are great signs.

You can do massage by going in the same direction as the muscle fibers (going with or against the hair), across the muscle fibers (going across the hair), or in a circular movement that will go both with and across the muscle fibers all at one time.

Slower is better. Use fairly slow, deliberate strokes that give you time to feel and assess what's under your hand. Fast, vigorous massage is not appropriate when doing grooming massage unless you are getting a horse ready for cross-country, racing or some kind of fast, explosive work.

How do you interpret what you are feeling? A muscle in good condition will have a smooth feel



without hard knots. Be aware that if the muscle feels overly smooth, like glass, the horse may be overly tight in that area. As your hand is going down the length of a muscle there should be a smooth glide; if your hand runs into hard or sore spots or a place that stops the smooth flow it indicates tightness that is not consistent with the rest of the muscle. You want to feel smooth, creamy peanut butter, not the chunky kind. Grooming massage works best on large muscle surfaces such as the long back muscles, the top and sides of the haunches, the shoulders, behind the shoulder and over the ribs, and the sides of the neck. It is best to work in the body of the muscle. Take care when working near the origin and insertion of the muscle fiber. The body of the muscle is generally fairly obvious to the touch. The poll is also a place that benefits from massage.

The horse's long back muscles are the ones that most commonly will be tight or sore, or both. The most common causes are bad saddle fit and poor riding techniques. Using your curry comb, heel of your hand or finger tips (depending on the horse's level of sensitivity) start with long gliding strokes that go from the withers to the croup bone. Then, going across the fibers, again work your way down the back from withers to croup, or you could use the circular motion. Your horse will tell you what works best. Do both sides of the back before going on to the haunches.

You will want to massage the top of the haunches (glutei and upper hamstrings) and the sides (quads and lower hamstrings). All three techniques (the fibers, across fibers or circular) work well here.

When working on the shoulders you may find going up and down the shoulder blades (with the muscles fibers) the most effective. It is awkward to go across the fibers or circular because of the spine of the shoulder blade.

Behind the shoulders and over the ribs will respond well to all three techniques. The area next to the elbow may be particularly tight or "touchy". The area of the ribs under a rider's leg is an important place to loosen muscles so that the horse can yield to the pressure of the rider's leg aids.

The neck can be stiff in many places from its base all the way to the poll. Start at the base and use long gliding strokes that go up the sides of the crest of the neck toward the head. You'll be going with the fibers (though against the hair growth). Work up the whole surface of both sides of the neck. Take caution when "rubbing" near the brachiocephalic muscle (the large muscle that runs parallel to the jugular). Feel free to use your rubber curry there, but avoid too much pressure next to the jugular.

Horses generally need a good deal of massage along the crest of their neck. There are 3 major muscles there that can greatly benefit because they are responsible for elongating the neck and allowing good flexion. Massaging this way will encourage your horse to stretch its neck. Most horses enjoy having this done with a flexible rubber curry comb.

The poll can be a sensitive area for many horses. If your horse will let you, use your finger tips to rub all around the ears and over the area just behind the poll. Whipp advises, "Be sure to trim your fingernails because you want only the pads of your fingers to make contact."

Loosening muscles with massage grooming will make your horse's body more comfortable and improve its performance, but there is one more advantage. Touching your horse is this manner can aid in overall awareness of where tight or sore area may be prevalent. As you gain awareness of the balance of your horse's musculature, you will be able to quickly assess potential problem areas. This increased awareness can help you develop exercises under saddle that address problem areas.

This grooming routine can take you beyond just grooming and into a greater awareness and understanding of what may be going on in your horse's body. One last benefit of your increased awareness of his body is a better ability to know when it is time to get professional advice, be that veterinarian, massage therapist, chiropractor, farrier or equine dentist.

Her owner, John Koltiska, had contacted me about finding a prospect. The first few I had looked at for him didn't pan out. I was in Buckeye, AZ for the winter futurities and talked to Jordon Briggs about what she might have for sale or know of and she told me about 'Techi'. I was familiar with Jordon and Justin's program and knew they would have a good foundation on her so we made the decision to buy her sight unseen. After John purchased her, she came straight to me in February of 2016. Justin had roped on her and she had the great foundation training I expected, so when I got her I worked on her for a few months and then started hauling and exhibitioning her. She was a little rough at first but it just took some patience to let her grow into herself, smooth things out on the barrels, and gain confidence. Her first futurity was the Classic Equine in Buckeye, AZ in January 2017 where she placed 7th in the first round, running a 17.4 on a standard pattern. From there, she went on to win the first round of the Greg Olson Futurity with a 17.0, running the fastest time of the futurity. In February, she won the average of the Xtreme Futurity in Fort Mohave, AZ with a 17.2, 16.9, and 17.3 on a standard pattern.

Techi runs in a short shanked Sherry Cervi bit with twisted wire dogbone mouthpiece. I ride Robbie Phillips and Shiloh saddles. Additional therapies include Back On Track, EquiVibe, Simply Equine supplements, and body work by Terri Kissack. She also swam at Famous Equine in December before the futurities started which really helped her start the year off strong.

I've really just tried to pay attention to how she's feeling and listen to her if and when she feels like she needs a break or something different to keep her enjoying her job. She's been a thrill to train and bring along and has a really neat personality.

I definitely think confidence in yourself and your horse is one of the most important aspects of training and competition. You and your horse have to feel good to do good, so I try to always keep that in mind and strive for confidence and a good foundation of training and health in my horses.

After the Kohr QH Futurity we are going to the Red Desert Classic and then will have a little break between then and the 5-State and Dash N Dance Futurities. We will go to a few local races and she will probably go swim at Famous Equine again to prep for the rest of the fall northern futurities. Our goal is to always do what's best for Techi while showcasing her talent.

I have to give a special thanks to my great friend Becca Gilley for helping me with warm up the day of the Kohr QH Futurity. A huge thank you to Koltiskas for trusting me from the very beginning and for being such great owners to ride for.



DOES YOUR HORSE NEED SUPPLEMENTS?

The question of whether or not to supplement a horse with vitamins, minerals, herbs, enzymes, amino acids or nutraceuticals will be asked and answered 100,000 times today. The answer in 99,999 cases will be accepted or rejected strictly on whether or not it was the answer the person asking wanted to hear.

There is no clear, factual answer. Science doesn't have a single answer; most answers lead to more questions. And most of the time the person asking about supplements didn't ask and answer the necessary preparatory questions. Is the horse actually lacking in a specific nutrient? How do you know? How do you know if you give a supplement it will work? Are you sure giving the supplement won't cause more problems than it will cure?

Supplements and nutraceuticals are a way to provide "what is lacking." So the first question must always be: "What is this horse lacking"?

Observation of the horse is the first diagnostic tool. Are the horse's eyes bright and clear? Does he have enough energy to perform the exercises being asked? Does he recover from exertion in a reasonable time? Is his coat healthy? Is he the right weight for his size? Be careful answering; most well-cared for horses are overweight.

And note: none of those questions had to do with the horse winning at competition—supplements can't make up for talent, training and the lack of a champion's "heart".

The second diagnostic tool is to learn enough about horse nutrition to know your feeding program is adequate. Get a hay test and know for certain the necessary nutrients are available in the forage. Determine the concentrates to be sure they are correct for the horse's age, activity and current health status. Weigh the forage and concentrate to be sure they are being fed in proper amounts—if you don't know what you are feeding, you can't know what is lacking.



Blood and hair analysis can be helpful, but only 'helpful'. Blood is self-regulating, (it has a strong tendency to remain normal) so it is a real challenge to determine nutritional problems. With hair analysis normal mineral ranges have not been determined and a universal standard has not been adopted; again the results may only be helpful.

Before trying supplements, try a consistent, effective de-worming program. Check with your veterinarian and work out the details based on the circumstances in your area. Absolutely guarantee your horse is getting all the clean, fresh cool water he desires. Have the horse's teeth checked (and floated often enough) for health and ability to chew comfortably. Now you can consider what might be lacking.

The Food and Drug Administration's Center for Veterinary Medicine regulates and enforces the laws regarding all feed ingredients, additives, supplements and drugs added to horse feed. Learn to read a feed tag; know what you are feeding. Terms on feed tags include: "GRAS" (generally recognized as safe). "Food" (an article that provides taste, aroma or nutritive value; GRAS (for example: hay and grain). "Food additive" (a substance that directly or indirectly becomes a component or otherwise affects

the characteristics of food.) "Drug" (any substance, food or non-food that is used to treat, cure, mitigate or prevent a disease.) If a nutrient is intended to nourish the body it is a food; if it affects the characteristics of the food, it is an additive. If the substance is used to treat an illness, it is a drug.

The most popular nutraceuticals are those claiming to improve joint health.

Glycosaminoglycans (CAG's), also known as mucopolysaccharides, are made up of natural components of cartilage and connective tissue and are present in all body tissue and fluids. Hyaluronic acid, chondroiton sulfate, dermantan sulfate, keratan sulfate, heparan sulfate and heparin make up the family of GAG's.

While these supplements are very popular and the claims for fantastic results abound, there is seldom any proof. In most cases, there is no baseline to determine degree of pain felt by the horse or joint function loss. Without a baseline, the results are a guess, a hope and a belief. Fat supplements to improve coat and promote weight gain are also popular. With these supplements, the results are often very observable...you can see the horse's coat has improved and it is easy to determine weight gain.

Vitamin supplements are popular, but often for the wrong reason. Vitamins do not provide energy as many horse owners believe. Vitamins do act as a catalyst, regulating the horse's ability to utilize other nutrients. When the horse is getting a well-balanced, nutritious diet, vitamin supplementation is virtually never needed. On the other hand, salt (a mineral) is almost always needed. The best way to provide the salt is to feed loose salt, free choice.

Other minerals seldom need to be supplemented, unless, of course, they are lacking in your area or your horse's daily diet.

If you are feeding a supplement to provide for what is lacking, you are doing the right thing...if you are feeding a supplement as a quick, convenient way to "insure" your horse's health, you've bought the wrong policy.


