LACEY DONEGAN HARMON & BRUNO

When did you start entering JUST THE WAY YOU ARE?

I usually run 4yr olds. Where I live the weather is great and there are unlimited places to season your colts all year. It's so easy to get your colts started early because there is so much time to get everything done. It really depends on the horse though; some horses just are not mentally ready to run as 4yr olds. Bruno's first run was at the juvenile race in Alvarado TX; then we went to the juvenile in OKC.

How did you know he would be ready for Slot races?


It's really just a feeling you have when you know you have an extremely talented horse. Entering a slot race is such a gamble because they are babies and you just really don't know how they will handle it. He had proven himself the weeks before that he was really coming on, so I was confident he was ready to enter.

What did you think your chances were of winning the LGPC Slot Race Championship?

Um ...I don't know...I felt really confident that I had a good chance but there are so many nice horses this year you just never know; I was really nervous before I ran because I really believed he could win if I rode him to his best ability.

How was your run in the long go of the LGPC slot race? Were you confident? Did you think JUST THE WAY YOU ARE would be ready to rumble this particular weekend?

He had a few mistakes in the long round that I wanted to try and fix, but overall it felt decent. Getting ready for the LG Classic, Bruno felt amazing at home; he was riding around very light on his feet and very responsive. I was confident he was going to have a good weekend.

Describe your finals run?

My finals run felt so smooth and quick--running down the alley he just felt like he had his game face on. When he turned the first barrel I felt like I had the barrel race won. It was so effortless and he left it so hard. I got my whip wrapped around my arm and whipped myself; I remember laughing about it because I thought 'don't mess this up' LOL...I knew I had just made a smoking run but I had no idea it was that fast. When I looked at the clock I kind of starting crying telling Bruno you just won the slot race...holy cow!!!!

How do you keep him in shape for these incredible tough events?


Knowing your horse, I think really helps--knowing what's too much and too little. I like to lope a lot of circles when I ride, but I don't work barrels very much when they already know the pattern. I use my exerciser a lot for walking a bunch to stretch them out.

How do you stay mentally prepared and calm for your run?

I've always been really good about not getting nervous; it's just kind of my personality to be laid back. But with futurities you have to leave your training at home and trust your horse knows what they're doing and stay positive.

Tell us about JUST THE WAY YOU ARE? Bruno is such a fun horse to be around; he's very personable and always into everything. I think it's because he had so much attention as a baby (his mom had a major injury right before he was born so she was always going to the vet). He was such a cute little baby. We saw Roosters Fame and loved his bottom side (Johnny Dial). We were at the Fizz Bomb one year and asked Jonee to bring him over so we could see him in person; he was beautiful and so well made. Bruno's dam Streakin Scat Cat is by Bob Troy out of Wimptas Scat Cat. Wimptas Scat Cat was known as "Bill" the mare. She was an amazing horse that won for every rider that was ever on her.







What bits do you use, saddle, therapies, etc?

I warm Bruno up in Dave Elliott Spur Up 02 with Mullen that has a cricket. I run him in the Spur Up 12 with a bead mouth piece. I love my Shiloh saddles. I'm a huge believer in the salt water cold spa, magna wave, flex neb! And when I'm home I use my Sport Innovations impulse blanket!

A training exercise you like...

One of my very favorite drills (I learned from my very good Italian friend Chiara) is using 4 tires and a large cone. Put 4 tires in a small-like square and the cone in the middle. You want the square small enough to make it difficult, but not too small where your horse can't actually do it. The goal is to get your horse to lope around the cone within the tires and learn to push through. It takes time and patience to get them to fully do it correctly. I start by just doing half of it at walk/trot, then build up. I like to switch it up and lope around the whole thing too.







I wanted something that was so fast that if I made mistake she would still clock; so I took a chance on a non- broke two-year-old, sight unseen, that was straight running bred. Later that year God saved her from having spleen surgery. He's proven to me that she is special and there's a reason why I still have her.

Any expectations going into this Futurity; and how did your runs go?

Honestly, my expectations were to make up for what I lost at Lance Graves Proclassic. I hit a couple barrels to win a lot of money. At this point, I know I have a horse that can win a futurity--not just place. She is an exceptionally fast mare. I was pretty pleased with her performance-both goes. Her turns in the first go were not as pretty as the second but she had a slip in the second and still managed to recover and shut the clock off.

The Patriot's Production...

I think the owners of the event have a great concept of providing all timed events in one location. The show is run *professionally*. They have tried every year to make the ground as good as possible.

What's next?

I have been resting her this week and I plan to leave for the Diamonds and Dirt on Monday. She is in the slot race there. Then I will prepare for the BBR Finals and the Jackson Hall Memorial Barrel Race that I produce and also compete at.

Barrel racing can have its ups and downs. Can you explain yours and give tips?

Experiencing 'difficulty' teaches you lessons. What we do with that lesson determines the outcome the next time. For instance, at the BFA Slot Race in Oklahoma City, I ran the second fastest time but had a slip behind the third barrel and caught it when I was leaving. I put the pressure of wanting to win their entry fee on myself and was very disappointed that I did not produce.





WHY DO WE REALLY HIT BARRELS?

By Windy Griffith

In Part 1 we looked at why we hit barrels in a different way--taking a look at the run from the very beginning that may have set you up to hit a barrel later in the run. Now let's look at another element that may have caused that barrel to go down.

BODY POSITION... Yes we all know that the rider's body position can cause a barrel to be hit. But do you really understand what body position means and why it may have caused a barrel to be hit? The position of the rider can dictate what the horse will do. As a rider you want to do your job and give your horse the most advantages in your riding to make that perfect run. If the horse makes a mistake you are able to quickly adjust their position because you will be in more control. So, I would like to break it all down of the "cause and effects" of a rider's body position.

HEELS DOWN... most riders have been told to always keep your heels down to keep you balanced in the saddle. I would agree with that basic term of riding. Keeping the heels down will help keep the body balanced and a rider can set their seat with control of their upper body as well. If a horse suddenly moves out of position, the rider will be able to maintain the balance needed to regain control and ultimately not lose their balance and fall off during the run.

Keeping your heels down is not always "easy". If you find yourself losing stirrups, falling forward in the turns or unable to keep your seat in the saddle play with your stirrup length; shortening or lengthening may just be the key to keeping your heels down easier once you find your correct stirrup length. I believe each rider has their own preference but comfort may not be the right length for a run. Each rider is different even when riding different horses so, trial and error. Let me challenge you to try a little change and see if this helps keep your heels down and increase balance in your run.



UPPER BODY ... if you can find the balance you need to in your heels it will make it easier to control your upper body. Barrel horses are powerful animals and can cause a rider to lose the control of their upper body easily. I like to teach my students to try and keep their shoulders square with the shoulders of the horse. If a rider is square with their horse it will be harder for a horse to dictate what the rider's upper body does in the run. You will also have more control of the horse because if the horse is making any mistake you have the ability to readjust the horse's position. For example, if a horse is coming into a barrel and wanting to turn too soon, you will be able to redirect the horse, verses dropping your own shoulder and getting sucked into the horse's momentum to start the turn and possibly hitting a barrel.



HAND PLACEMENT... high and low hands--it's all about the placement. Pulling on the reins at the wrong angle can cause a horse to get out of position or misread your cue. If you have good body balance it will ultimately make it easier to control your hands. The important thing is to make sure you understand how to communicate with how your horse is trained. Another idea is to play with the length of your rein. Rein length can help your timing and communication.

YOUR EYES... where a rider looks during the run is determined by the focus of the rider. All of a rider's body language can be told through the eyes of the rider. If you are not looking at the key spots of placement during a run, your body language will tell the horse that the rider is not in control and there is no game plan. Your eyes keep you focused on position and secure your body to a certain position of control. Training yourself to look where you need to place your horse is key to keeping those barrels up.



POOR BODY POSITION can get in the way of your horse in many ways and cause a barrel to be hit. Here are some more examples...

- If a rider is not seated for the turn, the horse cannot engage their hind quarter properly to make that
 driving turn. Finding your seat will give you the position needed to stay with your horse and not fall
 behind in your run.
- If a rider is not balanced and has too short of reins, they tend to use their reins to balance causing
 constant pressure on the horse. Horses lose their patience and start throwing their head and losing
 momentum during the run.
- If a rider is not in control of their upper body (rocking forward and backwards with upper body), even
 when kicking your horse, this can cause them to slow down because unnecessary movement is causing
 a huge distraction to the horse.



Continue Hitting Barrels...

Like we talked about in Part 1, barrels are knocked over because there was a loss of control during the run. A rider can lose control of their body position and be the cause of a down barrel. We are quick to pick out a horse being out of correct body position, but sometimes overlook if the rider was the cause. I bet you can think of at least one of these areas that you could improve on and see what may have been the cause of a barrel going down.

IN DEFENSE OF THE HORSE

Not all horse trainers are good, and not all are bad. But all get blamed at one time or another for something they have no control over--the horse which simply can't win in the show ring or at the track. Some horses lack good conformation, or smooth gaits, talent or speed. The owner may not believe it, but it is true. The trainer tries hard, does everything he possibly can, asks advice, works long hours, but still the horse can't win. Is it the trainer's fault? Sometimes, but only now and then.

When a person buys a horse, he's full of excitement, blind love, and the expectation of wonderful things. That's great. That's the way owning a horse should feel. But there must come a time when the owner has to face facts.

"Most owners," a Thoroughbred race trainer once observed, "think any horse they purchase will automatically run faster simply because it now belongs to them. And that is not realistic."

Some trainers will improve a horse's ability to run. Some will improve a horse's performance in the show ring. And, some will jeopardize the horse's chances. That's true, and that's what makes the fine line which separates the good trainers from the poor ones

The horse has a certain body structure. His bones only bend certain ways. No trainer can make them bones walk around in a different manner than they are physically capable of doing.

The horse has a mind that can learn and retain experiences, both good and bad. The good trainer fills the horse's mind with positive experiences, while the bad trainer fills it with fear. Whether he uses a good technique or a bad one, the trainer is attempting to assist the horse reach his full potential.

So a trainer can get the horse in good physical and psychological condition, and can prepare the horse for his maximum effort. But he can't make the horse run faster or perform better or behave better than the horse's potential. Ability is inborn--a trainer just brings it out.

Over the years I've watched horse owners switch horses from one trainer to another. Sometimes the horse improves, but most of the time it does not. I've heard owners criticize trainers, blame losses on politics, bad judging and bad luck. I've seldom heard an owner admit, "My horse just isn't good enough to win at this level."

If all this sounds like a defense of trainers, good and bad, it is not. It is written in defense of the horse, the good ones and the bad ones. Love him, care for him, use him...or abuse him...the horse is a fantastic animal. But like all other creatures, he is an individual, and he'll never be more than what he is.

Train the horse yourself or select a trainer and then give the horse your best effort by providing all he needs to reach his own potential. But don't abuse the horse by forcing him to be something he is not.

Be proud of his achievements, no matter what they are. If they are not satisfactory to youget a new horse. And keep in mind that after all, he's just a horse who has no expectations at alljust the desire to please.

THE LATE-TERM PREGNANT MARE, FOALING & NEWBORN FOAL CARE

From the last trimester of pregnancy through the foal's first month is a critical time. It is extremely important for horse owners to know what to expect. In this article I outline several important management points and concerns during this period.

THE LATE-TERM PREGNANT MARE

The average mare has a pregnancy of about 335 days, but normal pregnancies occasionally last over 365 days. The defining aspect of the last part of the equine pregnancy is that the fetus gains size and weight most rapidly during this time, doubling in size and weight during the last 4 to 6 weeks. This means that there are great physical demands placed on the late term pregnant mare during this stage. During their last 30 days of pregnancy many mares are sluggish, act depressed, eat less and generally just look huge and miserable. As mares near foaling, there is often a plaque of swelling (edema) that develops from the udder forward along the under-belly. This results from interference with the mare's circulation from the large weight of the pregnancy. Although this can become quite impressive as foaling approaches, it usually does not indicate a problem and resolves quickly after the mare foals. Often mare's hind legs "stock up" or swell with the added weight, but this also usually resolves quickly after foaling.

FEEDING THE LATE-TERM PREGNANT MARE

My recommendation is to feed a pregnant mare as if she isn't pregnant until she reaches the last few months of pregnancy. At that point, I recommend gradually increasing nutrition up to the time she foals. This may involve increased feeding of concentrates (grains) as well as more hay. I advise feeding a vitamin supplement as well as free choice access to salt and mineral.

The specifics of feeding depend on the breed and age of the mare and her condition as she enters this stage of pregnancy. The mare uses more energy – and requires more nutrition – from the last 6 weeks of pregnancy through the first 6 weeks after foaling than she does at any other time. For a mare that enters the last months of pregnancy in poor condition, it can be very difficult to feed enough to improve her condition. The best policy is to provide nutrition that allows the mare to enter this stage in excellent condition.

OTHER HEALTH-CARE POINTS

- Maintain pregnant mares on a consistent and appropriate parasite control program. I recommend deworming with a mild dewormer in the last 30 days before foaling.
- We recommend vaccination with at least Encephalitis/tetanus and West Nile Virus at the same time.
- The late term pregnant mare should also be in good dental health.

PREDICTING FOALING



Waxing of Teats - Often (but not always) seen just prior to foaling.

The appearance of the udder is important in estimating foaling. The mare's udder typically begins to enlarge at 4 to 6 weeks prior to foaling and gradually increases in size as foaling approaches. Immediately prior to foaling, the udder and teats are large and tight. The color and character of the milk is a good indicator of time to foaling. Until a day or two before foaling, the secretions from the udder are usually a clear to honey color. A few drops can be milked into your hand for examination. Usually within the last 24 – 48 hours the milk turns grayish and then white.

"Waxing" is often referred to as the formation of a tan waxy substance that forms on the tips of the teats. It is true that most normal mares give birth within 24-48 hours after the formation of this "wax." However, many mares never form wax, and so it is not a reliable means of predicting foaling. Another sign of impending foaling is softening of the ligaments around the tail head and elongation and swelling of the vulva.

There are many commercial "tests" used to predict foaling. Most of these rely on changes in the milk composition as foaling approaches. They can be useful tools but should not be thought of as foolproof. Ultimately, the best way to predict foaling is to combine all of the above factors with experience. Even then, predicting when a mare will foal can be tricky.

In our practice, we use the FoalAlert system, which consists of a transmitter that is sutured just outside the vulva. When the mare enters into labor (and the vulva separates), the transmitter is activated and the auto-dialer calls our cell phones. Since we live on site, we are able to walk down to our foaling stall, and monitor the foaling process from the beginning. We have found this system to be a reliable way to alert us when a mare is foaling.

FOALING

I feel that mares do best when they are allowed to foal in a clean pasture. Next best is a clean large stall (at least 12'x 20') bedded with straw, not shavings. The cleaner the environment, the better. Over 90% of mares have a normal delivery. While birthing can look dramatic, it is usually over within 20-30 minutes. The key is that the foaling should progress quickly.

First stage labor occurs before the foal is pushed into the birth canal and is characterized by the mare pacing nervously, lifting her tail, circling, and getting up and down. These symptoms usually last 10-30 minutes and can appear similar to colic. There may be some vaginal discharge during this stage. Next, the "water bag" (chorio-allantois) is presented as a clear sac containing a red wine-colored fluid. This is a signal of second stage labor. The foal is now in the birth canal and things start to happen fast.

Most mares lie down and strain intensely as the foal is pushed out. Once the front feet and head present, the foal is usually on the ground and struggling to gain its feet within 5-10 minutes. The placental membranes are often draped over the foal initially. The foal

usually breaks through these quickly but if an attendant is present, it does not hurt to cut or break the membranes to clear the foal's face. The umbilical cord remains attached until the mare breaks it when she gets up.

FOALING EMERGENCIES

Most mares foal normally and without incident. That said, when there is an emergency, quick and correct action is essential. For this reason, a good policy is to notify your veterinarian of the foaling so that if their help is needed they are prepared to arrive quickly.

If the foaling does not progress quickly and smoothly or you have any questions, it is always best to call your veterinarian then rather than waiting. Foaling emergencies include, among others, "dystocia" (difficult foaling usually resulting from improper fetal presentation or position), and premature placental separation (red bag delivery).

THE POST-FOALING PERIOD

A normal foal is usually up within 45 minutes from delivery, and nursing within an hour and a half. Meconium (the first manure) is usually passed within hours of foaling. Any straining to defecate indicates that an enema should be gently administered.


The mare's uterus begins contracting almost immediately after the foal is born. Many mares suffer from mild uterine cramping for a few hours after foaling and will show signs of mild colic. If these symptoms become severe, call your veterinarian immediately. If you treat the umbilical stump, only do it once and I recommend using a very dilute antiseptic solution. Strong solutions do more harm than good.

The placenta is usually passed within an hour or two of foaling. It is considered retained (abnormal) after 3 to 4 hours and you should call your veterinarian. A retained placenta in mares is a veterinary emergency. If the placenta stays in the uterus for too long, it will result in a life threatening uterine infection.

THE POST-PARTUM EXAM

I am a strong believer in a veterinary postpartum exam. This involves the veterinary examination of the mare, foal, and placenta at about 12 hours after a normal foaling. At that time, we perform a physical exam on the mare, paying special attention to her general physical health, normal lactation, and the area around the vulva and anus for birthing injuries. An exam at this stage can detect problems that, if left unchecked, can become serious.

- Foaling trauma to the mare is not uncommon and can be important to detect early.
- Problems causing colic signs are especially common in postfoaling mares and so special attention is paid to the health of the mare's gut and reproductive tract.
- The placenta is examined for completeness and normal appearance.
- All of the foal's body systems are checked, including limb conformation. Limb deformities are common in the newborn and are best identified and managed early.
- Blood is drawn from the foal for an antibody (IgG) test. The results
 of this test show whether or not the foal has absorbed
 adequate antibodies from the mare's first milk
 (colostrum). Failure of passive transfer is a common and
 potentially fatal problem that must be detected early.




