## Shelly Weaver & IMANONSTOP FAME 'Prince'

"I told Prince from the time he was born that he was born to be great."

As a child growing up my parents bought me a horse named Sister. I competed in the local round up club until I was 10 years old. My parents moved to the city so I didn't ride again for 26 years. In 2002 I married my husband Steve Weaver and we live in Bristow OK. In 2007 at the age of 36 years old I began riding again. It took hours and hours a day to get my balance back. There was a lot of sweat, tears and injuries to get where I am today. I had several people tell me "That once you stop riding and begin again after years being out of the saddle it's like riding a bike". This was a huge falsehood!

There was no fast-track way to get where I am. It took motivation and dedication. I set my goals yearly and worked every day to meet them. I have been fortunate that I have had some of the best coaches in the industry. In 2007 I qualified for the 2008 NBHA World Finals on two horses. In 2011 I filled my WPRA Permit and became a cardholder.

In 2010 I purchased Imanonstop Princess from Jackie Jatzlau. I wanted a horse that was a top pro rodeo caliber. I had been in love with Princess for several years. When I had the opportunity to buy her I jumped on it. Unfortunately Princess was injured shortly after I bought her, so I only ran her a handful of times. Since I already owned several Dash Ta Fame horses, I felt he would be the perfect cross with Princess. Prince was an embryo transfer and he was the first baby I had ever raised so he was handled and loved on daily. I have had several futurity horses that I have purchased but none that I have raised till now. Due to Princess's injury I always felt Prince was my blessing from God. I told Prince from the time he was born that he was born to be great. I truly believed this with all my heart.

In March of 2014 I sent Imanonstop Fame "Prince" to Jackie Jatzlau. Jackie would be training and competing on Prince for his Futurity and Derby years. Jackie has a winning history competing and training on this breed. When deciding which trainer I would send Prince to, the deciding factor was who I could ride behind. After riding behind Jackie for years I felt she was the best choice for me. I also had

to factor in someone that could handle high pressure runs. Entering these futurities is never cheap so having a jockey that has already been there was key. Jackie's successes range from NFR to Futurities.

In April Jackie called me and told me she was pregnant and said she understood if I wanted to send him somewhere else. We talked about some people he could go to and do well and I told her to let me just pray about this. The next day I called Jackie and told her that I felt Prince was right where he should be, so as long as she could ride him he would stay with her. If that meant he was behind kicking off the year, then so be it. I truly felt this was best for Prince. Jackie slow-worked him at her house until she was 7 ½ months along and then he came back home. Prince ended up getting a bad respiratory infection and was off for a month. After he was able to be ridden I started exercising him until Jackie was able to ride again and in November he went back to her.

We kicked off his year at BFA Juvenile placing 8th in the 2nd go. We didn't know it at the time but Prince had contracted Rhino--after his run he just didn't seem right. After a very stressful month Prince was finally released to go back to competing. Jackie only had two weeks to prepare for LG Pro Classic. In the 1st go we were 4th and 1st in 2nd go with the fastest time of the weekend. We also won Futurity Average Champion. Jackie then set her sights on RFDTV The American... Prince qualified with the fastest time in the semi finals. He won his spot in the finals at Cowboy Stadium. Prince had some ground trouble in the finals but handled it like a champ! To be a 4 year old and take that kind of pressure is amazing! He never seemed rattled by it even though he was the only baby there running against the best in the country. We didn't have the runs we wanted at Diamonds and Dirt or BBR but with some time off before Ft Smith he was ready. Jackie did a tremendous job jockeying Prince to this victory! I am so blessed for our entire Team that made this possible. To have the title of Futurity Champion at Ft Smith is such an honor.





#### MOLLY OTTO & SFW WONDER WOMAN

Molly Otto, 27 is from Grand Forks, ND. She is married to Andrew Otto and has 2 boys—Sterling 8 and Rowdy 5.

I started out riding... in the local 4H Club and open horse shows when I was about 13. I leased a horse for a year until my parents decided that I was not just going through a phase and they finally bought me my first barrel horse when I was a sophomore in high school. I did a few high school rodeos in Minnesota my senior year and then after I graduated I took a couple years off and then decided to attend NDSU where I participated on the rodeo team.

I had trained a few horses for myself and other people but nothing serious until 2011 when I trained my first "real" barrel horse, Eyema Rare Bug--'Fierce' and I won the SDSU Jackrabbit Stampede and she had only 4 months of barrel training and this was only her 5th competition away from home. I went on to win and place at multiple pro rodeos, futurities, and derbies on her until I sold her in 2013. I then purchased a horse in 2014 named Carmans Fantasy (Paris is what I call her) whom I trained and competed on in the Northern Region Futurity Tour. She was 3rd overall in the year end standings and was the 2014 WPRA Reserve World Champion Futurity horse. Paris has also placed at multiple pro rodeos.

Last year was when I decided that I really wanted to ride futurity horses and I purchased a prospect for 2015, SFW Wonder Woman, a 2011 buckskin filly by Sun Frost Wonder and out of Princess Lopesalot (Royal Quick Dash). She has been so fun to train. She is naturally talented and just figured it out instantly--she is so honest around her barrels and seems to really love her job.

twisted snaffle with a medium shank. She is at the point where I no longer work the barrels on her at home, I just mostly ride her out in the field or lope circles in the arena. I figure if she works well when I haul her there is no need to pick on her and create issues to work on. I think that really helps build her confidence. When I warm her up at the barrel races I will do some counter arcs and spin her around into my hand getting her softened up and responsive in her face, shoulders, rib cage, and hindquarters. She is really quiet and gentle but she does have some silly quirks (like any other great horses out there) that I've learned to deal with. She doesn't like to trot--she will walk or slow lope all day long which is fine because trotting is a lot of work for me so I'd rather lope as well. Running barrels

seems to be effortless and easy for her--she can literally fly

across the pen and make it look so smooth and easy. She loves

to hunt the barrels but she is very honest so I can just send her

up into the turn and sit there and just guide her around the

backside of the barrel. I feel that she runs the best when I just

sit up there and squeeze my legs and smooch to her rather than

kicking and being real aggressive.

More details about her winning horse....I ride 'Wonder

Woman' in my Lynn McKenzie Special saddle and I will ride

her in an o-ring twisted snaffle and run her in a Brittney Pozzi

Positive affirmations....When I am getting ready to compete on her I like to say a lot of positive affirmations such as I am confident, Wonder Woman is confident, she has perfect footwork around each barrel, my horse is a winner and so am I. I feel as if that gets my mindset ready to compete, which in turn gets my horse feeling confident and ready to go out there and compete as well.

My goals this year are to win the year end NRF Tour and hopefully get in the WPRA Futurity Standings. I am also hoping to compete at the Badlands pro rodeos and make circuit finals on both Carmans Fantasy and SFW Wonder Woman, but my main goal right now is to get to the futurities and derbies.

fluenza. It may also be confused with purpura hemorrhagica in which subcutaneous swelling of the legs is severe.

There is no specific treatment that is likely to modify the action of the virus but it is usual to administer antibiotics to horses with equine viral rhinopneumonitis to prevent and treat infection with secondary bacterial invaders. The treatment should be continued over 4-6 days. Warm, draft-free, isolated confinement should be provided if possible, with laxative foods and a constant supply of fresh drinking water.

#### WHERE IS 'YOUR' FIRE EXTINGUISHER?

This month I want to talk about fire extinguishers and to know where they are in your truck and trailer.

On May 1st I was coming home from a barrel race in Winona, MN and there is a big hill that comes down into LaCrosse, WI. Well a semi driver was flashing me as I got to the construction area. I kept looking to see what was wrong and I finally saw some smoke and then sparks coming from my driver's side trailer tires. I quickly decided I had to pull over to see what was going on. I pulled onto the edge of the single construction lane, got to the tire and saw it was on fire behind the wheel. I very quickly started to unload all four horses right onto the side of the interstate. My young friend Ashley held horses while I got them all out. (Ashley's first trip with me!) Next I tried to figure out how to get the fire out. I called 911 and told them my trailer was on fire and then while I was on the phone I remembered where my fire extinguisher was in the living quarters. I quickly jerked it out of its holder, pulled the release pin and put out the fire.

It was a very scary situation because my 20 gallon gas tank for the trailer generator is right behind the back tire plus we are very dry here in Wisconsin and we could have started the whole area on fire. That's why 911 sent three fire trucks and three police cars to help. The firemen and policemen were so kind and helpful. They proceeded to help get my tire off so I could drive it somewhere. My friend Terri came to take three of the horses for me. I put one horse in the trailer and limped it into LaCrosse. And oh, by the way, it was the brakes that locked up and the repair bill was about \$2,000—cheap compared to what it could have been!

The moral of the story is to have your brakes and bearings checked often (which I do) and to know where you keep your fire extinguisher. It could save your life, your horses and your truck and trailer. Thank you to everyone that helped two ladies in distress this past month.

## **EQUINE VIRAL RHINOPNEUMONITIS**

Serious outbreaks of upper respiratory tract disease can ruin a racing season, a show season and foaling season. Administrators of boarding and training facilities have become increasingly authoritative about vaccination requirements. Most of these outbreaks are caused by equine viral influenza. But when equine viral rhinopneumonitis is implicated, it can be devastating for the horseman and the facility itself. The problem is greatest where horses are housed semi-permanently in accommodations provided at the facility. In other circumstances where horses are in respiratory contact only on the day of training or competition, the outbreaks are much less serious.

The most serious outbreaks in horses occur in the winter and spring with equine viral rhinopneumonitis being the most common in winter and influenza causing most of the outbreaks in the summer. Two and three-year-old horses are the most frequent sufferers, as most four years of age or older appear to have developed resistance to the infections. In a horse population it is the average age and the mix of ages which largely determine its herd resistance, and when 30-40% of that population has not been previously exposed to infection then major outbreaks are likely. All of the equine respiratory viruses cause persistent reduction in the tracheal clearance rate of foreign material for at least 30 days. Clinical signs disappear much earlier than this and the recovery period should be extended to ensure that horses are not put back into work too early.

There are four common types of equine herpes virus (EHV).

- EHV-1 has a few subtypes. Subtype 1 is associated with abortion and subtype 2 is associated with respiratory disease, but also capable of abortion. EHV-1 is the most potent equine abortifacient.
- EHV-2 causes long-term infection in foals, some which develop clinical signs of purulent nasal discharge, fever and swollen lymph nodes in a syndrome that lasts about a week. It is rare for animals to die from this type.
- EHV-3 is a venereal disease manifested by lesions that start out flat, then pustular, then eventually ulcerative in the vaginal mucosa which is generally reddened. The ulcers may be as large as 2 centimeters in diameter and 0.5 centimeters deep and are surrounded by a zone of redness and inflammation.
- EHV-4 causes outbreaks of respiratory disease in any kind of horse population, at any time of the year.


The disease is highly infectious, and transmission probably occurs by the inhalation of infected droplets or by the ingestion of material contaminated by nasal discharges or aborted fetuses. Immediate infection can occur with the virus surviving for 14-45 days outside the animal. The duration of infectivity of animals is unknown, but it is probably some weeks and possibly longer because carrier animals seem to be necessary for persistence of the disease from year to year.

The disease is a mid inflammation of the respiratory tract of horses, characterized by coughing and nasal discharge. The importance of the disease is the large numbers of animals that can be affected in the outbreak, especially when horses are congregated in colder months. Fatalities in uncomplicated cases are unlikely, but affected animals are unable to work, racehorses have to break their training, and 'storms' of abortions occur in bands of brood mares, with as many as 80-85% of mares at risk either aborting or losing their foals during their first day of life.

Nervous system involvement can occur in an outbreak in which abortion and respiratory problems also are present. Outbreaks may be massive. It is most common in horses that become re-infected with the virus. The standard killed vaccine is not preventative but aids in the horse developing a certain level of immunity. There are modified-live vaccines available designed to aid in the prevention of abortion. The vaccine is designed to be administered at 5, 7, and 9 months of gestation.

The ataxia and paresis lasts for up to several weeks and is followed by recumbency. Some die after an illness of only 2 days. In a majority of cases, the patient has to be euthanized within a month. There have been reports of 50-60% of horses exposed to the respiratory form of the disease developed nervous signs. The disease can be reproduced experimentally and is characterized by an incubation period of 7 days.

As an upper respiratory tract infection it must be differentiated from strangles, with nasal discharge and swollen lymph nodes, from the more severe equine viral arteritis and equine in-



## MELANIE ADAMS & RGR LONER BOY

"The ability to read a horse is invaluable"

Melanie

Going into the weekend of the SWDC Futurity wasn't looking to be very good for our horses. My husband, Deloy Adams, and I had to scratch one of them--RGR Springloaded better known as Springer--due to an abscess. He is a 5 yr old, 16.2 hand gelding by Makn-Moves and out of Special Gigi which is an own daughter of Special effort.

Then our other gelding, RGR LonerBoy (Loner) was really tender footed when we unloaded him out of the horse trailer so I was unsure about running him. I called Hank Allred, our farrier, and told him we had a problem and within 2 hours he was on the road in the pouring rain to pad and Equi-Pak him. When he got the pads on he started to lick his lips and walked off strong but it wasn't till the next morning, the day of the 1st go, that we decided to go ahead and run him. Loner is a 5yr old bay gelding sired by LuckyMe Lonely You and out of Hugo Style, a double-bred Streakin Six mare.

Both futurity horses were bred and raised by the Rainbow Glass Ranch, Ross and David, and Ross's daughter-in-law Shawnalee Hinkins is their sales manager. She is also an awesome barrel racer and a brand new mother!! 'I love these people – they are a great group'.

I had won the Dixie Classic Barrel Futurity in St. George on Loner earlier in March. He ran 3rd in the 1st go and won the 2nd go also winning the Stallion Incentive and Open futurity average. We also ended up 2nd in the 1D open average just behind the great team of Kali Jo Parker and Tuneful. My husband also runs barrels on an 8yr old Zan Par Bar, Two-eyed Jack gelding called Sport. I had a futurity horse a couple years back but she had an accident at her first barrel race and really wasn't

able to run at 100%. But before that I hadn't run in a futurity since I left Texas 12 yrs before.

I trained barrel horses and sold them and then kept 1 or 2 to rodeo on; but after marrying Deloy 4yrs ago we talked about it and decided to get some young horses setting our sights on futurities. We have a 3yr old gelding RGR Jess Da Bomb by Nashville Rising (Mr Jess Perry x Morning Snow) out of RGR Bombay Day a Streakin Six mare. I also have a 9yr old black gelding, WM Jungle Love (Monkey), that I run at the Pro Rodeos he is by Smoke N Sparks and out of Gamblers Dilemma.

We have 3 futurities in June: the Dash For Dollars, Colorado Classic Futurity, and Red Desert Classic Futurity with our ultimate goal being the Parker Woods Memorial futurity. It ought to be an awesome futurity with some of the best horses running at it.

I have been involved in many disciplines of the horse industry from training barrel horses, race horses, roping, cutting and reining, but my one true love is barrel racing. I love training babies and I always keep in mind that each horse is an individual with their own style of running and turning—the ability to read a horse is invaluable. I also try to keep an open mind on bits and tack... for example, with Loner I tried to find a transitional bit for him but he loves his Skinner Draw bit, so I run him in it with a loose German Martingale. I want to keep my horses happy, healthy and loving their jobs. We have two vets that we use lot, Dr Duane Utley and Dr David Wolfe along with our horse dentist Shane Hatch, because as the old saying goes "It takes a Village".

### WHAT'S IN YOUR TOOL BOX?

#### TACK, KNOWLEDGE OR BOTH?

One of the most important training tools I have is consistency. All too often we see barrel racers ride differently at the race, whether it is due to nerves, pressure to do well, or riding in front of their peers. Our horses can also react differently in public as well because of nerves. I believe that being consistent in the way we ride is crucial. This means ride with the same posture and body position in public as

you do at home. Be consistent in the way you work the pattern and the maneuvers you ask of your horse. Be conscious of where your hands and legs are and what you are doing with them all the time. Hold yourself accountable when you make a mistake communicating cues to your horse. If you have been consistent and continue to be consistent both you and your horse will be confident.

ABOUT JOY – I am originally from Fort Bridger, WY and moved to north Texas in 2001 with my husband Trent. I started training futurity horses full time in 2012. A few of my favorites include Smokin Koa Lena, Cashin on the Bayou and Vegas Firefighter. I won the 2014 AQHA World Championship in Senior Barrels with Smokin Koa Lena. 





# CONSISTENCY CONSISTEN

The most important ingredient in any training program is consistency. This includes teaching children, dogs, horses or retraining ourselves mentally or physically. Specifically, with horse training, this means going out and doing the same thing with your horse every day until you and your horse master a technique or maneuver. Horse training is all about mastering the small fundamental exercises of body control. Even the most athletic maneuvers are simply a combination of small fundamentals put together seamlessly. The greatest horse trainers have figured this out and have become obsessive about mastering basic body control.

If you're training your own horse or trying to maintain the training your horse has received from a professional you must acquire or take on the mentality of a professional trainer. Horses do not care that you pay the feed bill, mortgage on the barn or even that you brag to your friends about how great or poor they are. We need to love and care for our animals on their terms, not ours. The amount of consistency that it takes to train a horse well is unfathomable to a novice until they have gone through the process themselves. There will be times when you feel you are being too demanding of your horse, but as you gain more experi-

ence and success you will find the balance that works for you. As you create more obedience and responsibility in your horse, you can then give them more freedom.

Having a timeline for training a horse will help you to understand how consistent you need to be. So I'm going to give you a fairly concrete idea of what markers and timelines to look for and progress towards. In three months a horse should have a basic foundation. This means they should be gentle and be mounted without much lunging. as well as walk, trot and lope around relaxed. You should be able to handle them through new situations with little difficulty. Past this point it will take two years to get a horse into the show pen or make them a considerably solid ranch mount. This will take riding five days a week with a week's vacation every six months or so and maybe a Friday off every so often if they've ridden very well Monday through Thursday. If this sounds like a lot of consistency you will need to recalibrate your scale. You may not plan on showing your horse or using them on the ranch everyday but that does not matter to your horse. For him to become the best at what you have in mind, he needs consistency at least four days a week.



## IT'S HAY MAKING TIME!

## What's in Your hay?

"For sale - Grass hay for horses. 50 pound bales. \$5.00 a bale. Delivery available."

Ads similar to this will be appearing across the country as the weather allows farmers to start making hay. But the advertisement leaves several unanswered questions....

## What is grass hay?

The most popular plant families used to make hay are grasses and legumes. Grass plants are monocotyledonous, which means one leaf sprouts from the seed. Leaves of grass are long and slender. Legumes are dicotyledons, which means two leaves sprout from the seed. The leaves are generally three leaflets attached to a petiole (stem). Legumes develop nodules on the roots which interact with bacteria and produces nitrogen needed for growth. Legumes produce "pods", which contain seeds. Nutritionally, grass hay will be lower in protein and calcium than hay that is made with legumes. Legume hay (alfalfa, clover, trefoil) will also have a higher energy content.

Within the grass family are many varieties, which are broken into two groups: cool-season and warmseason. Cool-season grasses grow best in temperatures between 65 and 75 degrees Fahrenheit. In the United States they are commonly grown in the upper regions (northeast, mid-west and Pacific northwest). Examples of cool-season hay grass varieties used for horses are timothy, orchard grass, Kentucky bluegrass, fescue, bromegrass and ryegrass.

Warm-season grasses are adapted for the warmer temperatures of the south and southwest. They will go dormant when temperatures drop below 65 degrees Fahrenheit. The most popular warm-season horse hay varieties are Bahia grass and Bermuda grass.

What type of grass was used to make the hay in the advertisement? It is possible the hay producer does not know. Unless the fields have been maintained with proper weed control, fertilization and reseeding (with known grass varieties) the consumer may be buying weeds. For example, a warm-season weed called Johnsongrass is toxic to horses, but looks beautiful when growing. A volunteer (not purposely planted) cool season, non-endophyte free fescue grass can cause abortion, foaling problems and lack of milk production. Native grass varieties can make good hay, but they should be identified and confirmed they are not toxic to horses.

All plants drop in nutrition and digestibility as they mature, and should be harvested at the peak nutritional stage. This is generally before the boot stage - before the seed heads appear. Unfortunately weather plays a big part in the timing.

How mature is the hay in the ad? An examination to determine the stage of the seed heads, and the coarseness of the stems will give the buyer insight to the nutritional value and digestibility of the hay. Very mature hay will be wasted by the horse. Supplementation will be required to make up for the nutritional deficiencies. Older horses, or horses requiring dental care, will have trouble chewing the coarse forage. The non-digestible parts of the hay will also lead to an expanded cecum (hay belly).

Before writing a check for the "grass" hay, do your homework and make sure you are getting horse quality forage.



## **ESSENTIAL OILS**

The smell of a horse can be calming to those of us who love them. Many people who do not ride, keep a horse. When asked "Why?", a common answer is "I need the smell of a horse in my life".

The olfactory system (the mechanism that enables smell) is not as well developed in humans as it is in many animals. But yet a whiff of a certain scent can trigger a pleasant or unpleasant feeling, calmness or anxiety.

The art of aromatherapy uses the sense of smell to help support the body during an illness or time of stress. Therapeutic essential oils are the key to this interesting and helpful therapy. "Essential" had many definitions. One that comes to mind is: "something that is required, fundamental or indispensable". But in the aromatherapy arena, the definition of "essential" is: "the quality or nature that makes something what it is its essence."

Essential oils are different than perfumes. Perfumes can be made from manufactured chemicals and can contain artificial ingredients. Essential oils are natural and contain the molecules from beneficial plants--tapping into their "essence".

To administer the essential oil, via aromatherapy, allow the horse to sniff the bottle of oil. If he avoids the offering, do not keep insisting-this is to be pleasurable, not a fight. If the horse likes it, you can now dab a small amount of diluted oil in his stall or paddock area, so he will have the opportunity to partake at will. You may also apply a small amount of the diluted oil (not more than a drop) on the chest, neck or forehead. Be sure to steer clear of any mucous membranes. The aroma will waft up to the nose. The equine sense of smell is much stronger than ours so do not use capacious amounts - just a drop is all that is needed. Monitor the area and discontinue if skin irritation appears.

Essential oils can also be used topically. A massage using the diluted oil can help relax the horse...and you. Some oils have antiseptic properties which may help ease irritation of a minor wound. Consult your veterinarian before using essential oils on an injury.

There are many essential oils, and each one has specific targets. For example, lavender is known for its calming, almost sedative properties; rosemary is considered to be a stimulant-keeping the subject alert and focused.

How often you use essential oils depends on the product and manufacturer. Follow the directions and buy from reputable dealers.

Do not use essential oils internally without consulting a professional. Giving your horse essential oils orally can cause digestive upset or other issues.

Just as the essence of the horse can help us during periods of grief or sickness, we can also help them. Consider the use of essential oils for your horse during times of stress....soothing to both you and your horse.
