

PREPARING FOR DELIVERY

The average length of pregnancy in the mare is 338-343 days. However, normal gestation can range from 320-380 days. You needn't become overly concerned if your mare is past due. Prolonged gestation is not generally associated with problems or extra-large foals unless the mare is grazing endophyte-infected fescue grass. If your mare's pregnancy extends much past 340 days or you're concerned, ask your veterinarian to examine her to determine if the mare is still pregnant and confirm that all is well.

If your mare has made it through 11 months of pregnancy, you're almost home free. Labor and delivery, while momentous, are generally uncomplicated. Every effort should be made to be present during foaling. In most cases, you will simply need to be a quiet observer. Mares seem to prefer to foal at night in privacy and to have some control over the delivery. Hiring a foaling attendant, installing a video monitor, or using a birth alarm system can save the life of the foal should a problem arise. It is advisable to have your veterinarian's telephone number nearby in case of an emergency.

Should you choose to foal your mare in a stall, provide one that is a minimum of 14' x 14'. If possible, the stall should have adequate bedding and a floor that can be readily cleaned and disinfected. Dirt or clay floors make sanitation more difficult. Straw is preferable to shavings, as it won't cling to the wet newborn or mare the way small wood particles can.

Mares provide clues that they will soon give birth; however, the timetable is far from absolute. Some mares will show all the signs like clockwork; others show practically none. The following is a general guideline, but be prepared for surprises:

- ~The mare's udder begins to fill with milk two to four weeks prior to foaling.
- ~The muscles of the vulva and croup relax.
- The teats become engorged four to six days prior to foaling.
- ~"Waxing" of the teats occurs (a yellowish, honey-like secretion [colostrum] appears one to four days prior to foaling.
- ~The mare becomes anxious and restless. She may appear to be colicky. She may kick at her belly, pace, lie down and get up, look or bite at her flanks and sweat. She may frequently raise her tail and urinate. Generally, this is the first stage of labor.

Labor is divided into three stages:

Stage one begins with the onset of contractions and generally lasts one to two hours. During this phase, contractions move the foal through the cervix and into position in the birth canal. The fetal membranes may become visible at the mare's vulva. When the sac breaks, signaled by a rush of fluid, stage one ends

Stage two is the actual expulsion of the foal. This phase moves relatively quickly. If it takes more than 30 minutes for the mare to deliver, there is most likely a problem. If there is no significant progress within 10-15 minutes after the membranes rupture, call your veterinarian immediately. If labor seems to be progressing normally, wait and watch. Normal presentation of the foal resembles a diving position, with front feet first, one slightly ahead of the other, hooves down, followed closely by the nose, head, neck, shoulders, and hindquarters. If you notice hoof soles up, the foal may be backwards or upside down, and you should call your veterinarian immed-

iately. The most deadly of foaling emergencies is a premature rupture of the chorioallantois, known as a "red bag delivery". If at any time during stage two you see red/maroon membranes covering the foal as it emerges from the vagina, the placenta must be rapidly torn open. The foal is detached from its blood and oxygen supply. Normal membranes that cover the foal are white or yellow and translucent.

Stage three labor begins after delivery and is the phase during which the afterbirth (placenta) is expelled. Most placentas are passed within one to three hours after the foal is delivered. If the placenta is not passed within three hours, call your veterinarian. A retained placenta can cause serious problems, including massive infection and laminitis.

Most mares foal without difficulty. It usually is best to allow the mare to foal undisturbed and unassisted. If a problem becomes apparent, contact your veterinarian immediately.

TRAVELING TIPS

by Sandi Brandli

We all know that during this time of year Wisconsin is cold, making it a challenge to keep your horses in shape. There are hardly any barrel races to go to, which also makes it almost impossible to keep that competitive edge with the fast approaching rodeo season. With training horses for a living, as well as competing in professional rodeo with my own horses that I have trained, I am able to leave the cold weather of Wisconsin for around a month each year. I am going to share with you some helpful tips I have learned to make my travels down the road a little easier.

When I travel by myself for a winter run in Florida there are a few things you should be aware of while traveling. I usually have a list going and try to load everything before my departure so that I have a few days to think about anything extra I might need. I pack hay, grain, water, saddles, bridles, pads, wraps, etc... I don't want to change my feeding program while on the road. If I have a horse that needs extra stuff like ulcer guard or any medication, I make sure I have it packed and ready to go.

While traveling to Florida I like to plan my trip so I can stop and get stalls to rest my horses. It's very hard on horses to travel for 24 hours straight; they need to be able to get their heads down to clear their airways. I will unload my horses every five hours if weather permits to give them a drink and walk them for ten minutes or so. I know I get sore driving that long, so I am sure they do.

I also want my truck and trailer in tip top shape. The truck will have an oil change done and tires checked before I go; the same with the trailer. I need to check the tires and brakes and grease the bearings at least twice a year. I have had the brakes on my trailer go out on top of a Colorado Mountain and it was not fun. I almost got the horses out of the trailer and rode down the mountain. I did learn something very helpful in that experience. If you have no brakes to come down a mountain, you can put your truck in 1st or 2nd gear and 4 wheel drive low and the truck will come down the mountain at no faster than 15 miles per hour. Really good to know!

Among other things I pack for emergencies on the road might be extra fuel, extra fuel filter, and a product called 911. 911 is a diesel additive that will save you if you get bad fuel. I learned that on my travels also. I used it in my truck and it was able to clean up the bad fuel after idling for 15 minutes. Really a great product to know about--it has helped many of my friends.

Another thing I do while traveling by myself, is to travel during the day time. That way there are always people around and businesses open in case I need help. I like to fuel at gas stations in the country rather than in cities because they are less busy, you feel safer, and I am usually able to get the horses out.

One more thing to remember is there are horse people everywhere and most are more than willing to help you if you need anything so don't be afraid to google a horse farm and ask them where to get some help. I am always ready to help if someone calls me....Well I hope these few tips will help you in your safe travels because they were hard lessons learned.

SIMPLICITY

Barrel racing is simple right? Is it or is it not? Do we as competitors make it more complex than it needs to be? I believe the answer to this question is that we have made things a little too complex. We need to go back to "simple" a little more. It seems that when we stop winning we try whatever feed, bit, pad, shoe excuse that will give us that winning edge. I am the first to admit of following this habit. When I started barrel racing I had a little mare. I won more on this horse than any horse I have competed on. I fed her hay and water not 10 different supplements (I did that later in her life when I stopped winning.) I paid \$350 for my saddle (which I sold later to buy a very expensive pad that was supposed to make her win later in her life). I knew nothing about pocket, hand placement, or ground. I just wanted to run barrels (I later started pulling on her head and worrying about ground when I stopped winning). The years that I had simplicity I won at college, amateur and pro rodeos. I had no idea what I was doing or where I was entering; all I knew is that I wanted to rodeo and I was having a blast doing it. So what happened? This event that once was so simple--run around three cans and fastest horse wins-became: what supplement can I feed? What bit do I use? Change this, change that. I still find myself doing this with not only this great horse but with all the other horses I have had. Looking back I realize that taking a step back and going back to basics maybe is a better answer; being a little more consistent in my actions. Change needs to happen but we also need to remember that simplifying things is good too. This includes the feed and training, but also the mental stuff too. I am sure I will at some point get trapped into the chaos of 'I have to win!' but hopefully I can reflect and realize I need to simplify more, rather than add more chaos.





IS YOUR HORSE WORTH HIS SALT?

The ancient Greeks traded salt for slaves – hence the saying "worth his salt". Early Roman soldiers were partially paid in salt (salarium argentum, which is where the word "salary" originated).

Salt is an essential nutrient – the body needs it, but cannot manufacturer it. Salt must be provided in the diet. A severe salt deficiency can cause your horse to die. Napoleon had thousands of soldiers die during his retreat from Moscow when wounds would not heal due to a "salt deficiency".

Salt consists of sodium and chloride (NaCl). Sodium is an electrolyte. Electrolytes are electrically charged particles called ions. These ions can be lost through sweat. They are necessary for cellular metabolism, a balanced cellular system and the production of energy using calories. Sodium helps maintain hydration and is important to muscle contraction and nerves. Chloride is an electrolyte. It has a negative charge while sodium has a positive charge. The balance between the two helps maintain healthy blood cells.

Blood is self-regulating (homeostatic). It will go to great lengths to maintain its normal stability – even to the point of robbing nutrients from other organs. If salt is not available through diet, the blood will steal the salt present in urine and sweat. But urine and sweat production cannot be stopped and the blood returns the salt to the kidneys and sweat glands. The body tries to maintain itself by diluting the urine and sweat with more water to try to keep from robbing the salt from the blood and excreting it. The body's tissues become dehydrated while the blood tries to maintain its normalcy.

An average sized horse (1100-pounds), at rest, needs about two ounces of salt per day. (Approximately six teaspoons equals one ounce.) Four to five ounces may be needed on hot days and during strenuous exercise when sweat is being produced.

Salt and water...it's simple and it's cheap...and your horse is worth it.

There is some salt in commercially produced feeds. If the product is fed according to the feeding directions an ounce of salt per day may be provided by the feed. This is not enough salt. Salt must be provided in some form...block or loose. I do not like salt blocks. Blocks of salt were designed for cattle--cattle have rough tongues. That is why many horses bite and destroy the blocks...they are trying to get the needed salt. I recommend loose white granulated salt – it looks just like table salt. Local feed stores will have it in 50-pound bags. It will be more economical than the blocks. You will get more salt for your money.

Horses that are salt-starved must be introduced to salt slowly--salt poisoning is possible if salt is suddenly available. Symptoms of salt poisoning are digestive upset and cramps.

Salt is the only mineral which horses know they need. Horses can be deficient in copper or any other mineral and not consume the needed amounts when they are available. But horses will eat salt if their body needs it

Along with salt, horses need water. Water is the most important nutrient. Increased consumption of salt will increase water intake. A full salt feeder next to a fresh clean bucket of water is required in all horse areas – at all times


COLLECTION

Each step of a barrel racing horse's training is intended to lead to flawless turns that are fast and free. For the horse to develop that turn they need to be taught to give their head so the rider can drive the horse's hind end up under them and keep it there with their legs. When a horse gives their head the rider can begin to lift up their back with their legs and begin to teach the horse *collection*.

From the beginning of a young horse's career it is important to teach that horse to give their head at the poll when pressure is applied to the reins or to give their head to the side when asked. At Roeser Ranch we start in the round pen by bitting up our horses so they learn to move forward into the bit and give their heads. When we bit up a horse,

ABOUT

Jacklin (Jackie) Roeser was born in 1955 in Gooding, ID to Elmer and Ruth Ellen Parke. She started showing horses in 4-H and then rodeos through college. After graduating college in 1977, Jackie started a 20-year teaching career and she once compared teaching children to training horses saying it was about the same... we use a snaffle bit and tie the reins behind the cantle of the saddle tight enough that the horse gives his head to the pressure of the bit and cannot toss his head in the air. Then we move them forward in the round pen first at a walk, then a trot and eventually a lope. It does not have to be done fast. You want the horse to learn to be comfortable and relaxed moving around you in the round pen without you being on their back. Once they have learned this, we ask them to turn into the fence, collecting their bodies, and turning off their pivot foot. This step is the beginning of a horse learning to collect for a turn by moving their shoulders across the turn, placing the inside

National Reined Cow Horse Hall of Famer-Jim Roeser (who pointed her in the direction of horse training). She continued a successful barrel racing career for several more years earning many champion-ship awards; then after the birth of their daughter, Annie in 1984, they bought a place and started training barrel racing horses and cow horses. To date, Jackie and Dan have bred and trained 22 barrel racing futurity and derby champions that have gone on to win at the amateur and pro rodeo level. Jackie continued to rodeo from 1990–2009 at the pro rodeos in the Northwest and California.


In 30 years training horses she has only bought 7 early in her career and 2 most recently. "I always ride mares because of their heart and try and for breeding purposes." Some of Jackie's favorite horses include Azure Bid, Fantastic Rocket, Sovereign Judgment, Circles Top Illusion, Miss Might Flight, Jimmy Some Sugar, and CT Tres (a daughter of Circles Top Illusion). She is currently training 3 more she is hoping will make it to the winners circle especially one, Easy Movin Chic (a granddaughter of Circles Top Illusion).

Besides the barrel racing horses Jackie has trained, she and Dan have built a horse training stable with customers from Washington, Oregon, and Idaho. Dan has become a nationally known reined cow horse trainer who serves on the National Reined Cow Horse Board of Directors. He is also a past president of the NRCHA, Idaho AQHA, and the IRCHA. Besides Dan's numerous rodeo winnings and championships, he has won numerous NRCHA and AQHA awards. They have also created a breeding program where they have stood up to 7 stallions in a breeding season. Jackie and Dan have said, "Our life style of training and showing horses has not always been easy, but it has been rewarding. We have built our business ourselves, we have been our own boss, and we have been rewarded by the true friends we have made along the

hind foot up underneath them for an easy turn, and to push off that pivot foot.

By teaching our horses this first step, we avoid head throwing and hollowing out of the back. This leads a horse to easily learn to backup. Once they have learned to give their head they can be taught to collect their back end, pick up their shoulders, and move their hip off the rider's leg to start learning to stop and collect for a turn. It is important for a barrel horse to learn to keep the forward motion when they collect and that is why we also teach them to ride up into our hands. All of this is done in a forward motion pushing with the back legs and moving the shoulders across and around the barrel.

When a young horse is started on the barrel pattern it is all about teaching the horse where to place his feet; and because I am not fighting with the head I can spend my time moving the hips with my legs and their shoulders with my hands and legs. These important first steps come into play when you need to correct a habit that might form from a horse getting sore, lazy, or thinking they know more than the rider. I can go back to the basics and fix the way the horse might have started using their body like dropping their shoulder or hollowing out their back.

Keeping a horse's back rounded also helps when a horse is on bad ground. If you watch a barrel race on bad ground, those horses that have learned to stay up under themselves with their shoulders up can get around the barrels without slipping or falling down. Most of the time when a horse goes down it is from a dropped shoulder or a horse being strung out behind.

It has been debated over the years by barrel racers whether a horse that has been taught to bridle up is too broke. Many successful barrel horses have not been taught to bridle up, but for me the benefits of teaching my barrel horses collection have been an integral part of their development.

TOUGHEN SOFT SOLES

On the Adriatic Sea lies the city of Venice, Italy. For centuries it has been a port through which exotic products such as silk, porcelain, spices, gems, wine and Venetian turpentine have been exported.

"Venetian turpentine?" you ask.

Yes, the honey colored, sticky substance you put on your horse's hooves derives its name from Venice, Italy.

Venice or Venetian turpentine is made from the sap of the European larch tree (larix decidua), which is native to central Europe, the Alps, the Carpathians and Poland. It has also been successfully cultivated in northern regions of North America.

Venice turpentine is used on horses' hooves to toughen the sole. It creates a barrier to protect against moisture. Soft soles are caused by too much moisture. Horses standing in mud or wet stalls are prone to this condition. Other causes are applying too much hoof conditioner, over soaking hooves (to treat another condition such as an abscess) and wearing pads.

In order to apply the product the sole must be clean. Start by using a hoof pick to remove the bulk of the imbedded dirt. Follow with a brush to remove the small particles left behind. Spray a solution of 50% bleach and 50% water on the sole to kill bacteria. Without letting the hoof touch the ground, apply the turpentine to the sole with a hoof applicator brush or old toothbrush. Many people will then apply a piece of heavy brown paper that is cut slightly bigger than the hoof directly to the sole. This keeps dirt from sticking to the product, and will protect your mat or floor from getting too much of the sticky turpentine on it. The paper doesn't stay on long, but will offer some protection. Continue to treat the soles daily until the horse is sound. Each application will add to the previous layer until a substantial barrier is built up.

Venice turpentine should not be applied to the frog, the bulbs of the hoof, to the coronet band or above it. The frog (the "v" shaped portion of the bottom of a horse's hoof) is designed to be dynamic. It flexes as the hoof hits the ground - absorbing shock. The bulbs also are flexible and should not be hardened. Venice turpentine is a counter-irritant. Counter-irritants create inflammation on the skin surface in an effort to draw healing properties to underlying muscles or joints. Avoid getting Venice turpentine on and above the sensitive coronet band because this will cause discomfort and needless pain to the horse.

When shopping for pure Venice turpentine, beware of imitation or artificial products. Look for products that state they are 100% Venice turpentine. However, there are commercial products that may use a blend of Venice turpentine, iodine, acetone or other ingredients. These products will also work toward hardening the sole.

While Venice turpentine will toughen your horse's soles - management is the key. Mud and excessive moisture will lead to long-term problems that no exotic import from Italia will cure. The ground upon which your horse is standing must be changed to create a healthier environment. Consult with your farrier and veterinarian for proper hoof care techniques.




